State Level Conference on 'Recent Trends in English Studies and Research'

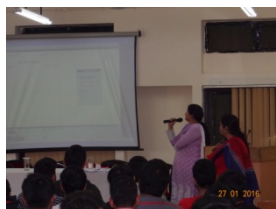

In its second year 2015-16, 40 students have successfully completed this course. In academic year 2016-17, 07 students enrolled for this course.
