The inauguration of the workshop was done at the hands of Dr. N.S. Umarani, Pro-Vice Chancellor, SPPU, Pune.

Mr. C. Vasudevan, CGN, Head, BSE-IPF Limited, Mumbai, CMA Amit Apte, President, ICAICAMA, Kolkata were the Chief Guests for the workshop and Mr. Sunil Kadam, Registrar, NISM, Navi Mumbai was the Guest

of Honor. Mr Kushal Hegde, President, Kannada Sangha, Pune, presided over the function.

The workshop got special guidance from renowned CA. CV Chitale, Member, Central Council ICAI, New Delhi. Mr. Mukund Sabu Consultant, Mr. Sudeep Moitra- Financial Advisor, Mr. Neeraj Kapoor, Finance Expert and Consultant, Mr. Mahesh Gowande, Director, Ayan Analytics Ltd, Ms. Priyanka Sumant, Chief Manager, COSMOS were among other dignitaries.

In his welcome speech, Principal Dr. Ashok Agrawal spoke about the glorious achievements of Kaveri Group of Institutes in the field of Education. He applauded the contribution of BSE-IPF in making people aware about financial management, investments in capital market etc. In his inaugural speech, Dr. N. S. Two-Day State Level Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on E- Content Development

Two-Day State Level Faculty Development Programme (FDP) on E- Content Development was organized on 5-6 January 2019 by IQAC and KSDC in association with Knowledge Bridge, Ahmednagar. The Resource Person for the FDP was Mr. Bhushan Kulkarni. He explained how to

develop E-content and how to use different software packages and apps to edit video/audios. During the programme the participants were guided about the different apps and their uses for both educational and commercial purposes, different types of hardware required for audio and



video recording, professional microphones and their usage, quality audio recording and special effects, multi track recording, mobile screen recording techniques, power point presentation (PPT) of video using android smart phone, best audio video shoot using mobile camera, types of educational videos, live streaming using smart phone, concept of video production and film making, documentary production techniques, PPT to video on computer, understanding chroma effect, prerequisites for chroma shoot, chroma and PPT video mixing, etc. There were 115 participants from places like Mumbai, Bhor, Velhe, Indapur and Pune city who benefitted from

Kaveri Skill Development Cell (KSDC)

The Kaveri Skill Development Centre (KSDC) conducted its first activity in the academic year 2018-19, 'Certificate Course in Share Market and Mutual Fund Investment' from 6 to 16 August 2018. Renowned Business Journalist Prof. Nandkumar Kakirde and stock market faculty Mr. Sadanand Soman were invited as resource persons for conducting the Course. Dr. Muckta Karmarkar, Vice Principal, Kaveri College and Mrs. Suchismita Mohanty, Head, KSDC were present on the occasion of inauguration of the course. In her inaugural speech Mrs. Mohanty

informed that KSDC was established to provide students with industry-relevant skills and avail practical training in order to enhance the employability quotient. She urged students to get benefitted from the varied initiatives under KSDC.

KSDC conducted another course, 'Certificate Course in Soft Skill' from 17 to 25 January, 2019.



Mr. Munir Damani, a Soft Skill Trainer was invited as resource person for conducting the Course. students were introduced to various leadership traits through different activities like lectures, presentations, role play, singing etc.

In his welcome speech he spoke on the importance of

Research and Analytical aptitude in students' life and said that everyone should have curiosity while researching and should achieve the greatest mastery over their chosen field. He introduced students about the State Level Project Competition Avishkar and other various scholarships given by the R & D department of the University.



Dr. Hebalkar referred to research as a systematic investigation in order to establish facts and draw conclusions. She explained the concept of research by giving various examples and defined research as a careful and detailed study into a specific problem using a scientific method. It is a systematic method of data collection, sample size, surveys. She touched upon various factors related to research methodology viz. how to choose a topic for the research, how to collect information, how to think, how to select variables etc. More than 100 students of the College were present for the session.



The second session on 'Research Methodology' was organized on 28 August, 2018. The resource for the session was Dr. Rashmi Hebalkar, Chairman–ISTD. The main motive behind organizing this session is to explain 'Research Methodology', to motivate the students to start research in their respective subjects and encourage them to participate in the research project competitions organized by various Colleges and Universities. Dr. Hebalkar explained various ideas of research projects. Further she explained,

how to select the topic of research project, how to write hypothesis and report of research project. Main objective of this session was to encourage the students to participate in AVISHKAR 2018-

19 Inter University Research Project Competition for UG/PG/Doctoral students organized by SPPU.

Total 9 groups from BA, B. Com., BBA, B.Sc. (CS) and M.Sc. (CS) participated in AVISHKAR-2018 in this academic year. Three groups qualified first round and presented their research work in the second round.

Exhibition of research projects was organized on 9 January 2019 by the Centre. Dr. Ashok Agrawal, Principal and Dr. Muckta Karmarkar, Vice-Principal inaugurated the exhibition. Dr. Agrawal appreciated the efforts taken by the students and congratulated them for participating in the University level competitions. The students of B.Com., BBA, B.Sc.
