Yoga Day Celebrations

The Fifth International Yoga Day: The Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June, 2019 with great enthusiasm. The event was organized in association with Datta Kriya Yoga International Pune Center. Dr. A. J. Thanawala from Datta Kriya Yoga International Pune Center, explained the importance and benefits of Yoga to the staff and the students of the College. Dr. Thanawala conducted a session on Nadi sudhi, meditation, Pranayam and breathing techniques, and musical meditation for the participants.

A Tree Plantation Activity

The tree plantation activity was organized at **Taljai hill**, Pune on 24th July 2019, under NSS. Principal Dr. Ashok Agrawal, Vice Principal Dr. Muckta Karmarkar, staff members and students participated in this programme. They motivated students by participating in this programme. Forest Guard - Rohini Gadge was also present on this occasion.

Mr. Sachin Deokate, Program Officer for National Service Scheme, informed the students about the issue of environmental conservation and made them aware about the causes and side effects of global temperature rise. Mr. Sumedh Waghmare, who is popularly known as "Birdman" entertained the students by mimicking Bird sounds such as peacock, pigeon, bulbul, and inspired them to enjoy nature. He helped spread awareness among the students about the importance of birds and the environment of birds.

Tree planting program consisted of digging pits for planting trees, planting trees, and watering trees, cutting weed and cleaning the surrounding area. The volunteers also collected plastic and
