Student Development Committee

Report for Academic Year 2018-19

The Board of Students' Development Unit of the college functions according to the directions of the Board of Students' Development Unit of Savitribai Phule Pune University. Following are the activities conducted under various schemes of BSD SPPU throughout the year.

- An awareness drive for enrolling names of eligible students for voter list was conducted
 in the first week of June. The voter ID forms of students under Kothrud Matdar Center
 were collected and submitted to the same.
- In the **first week of July** the awareness drive for **Anti Ragging** was conducted. Later all the students duly filled and submitted Anti Ragging undertaking forms in the department.
- In the first week of August interviews for Karmaveer Bhaurao Patil Earn and Learn Scheme were conducted. Total 18 students from various faculties were selected for the scheme.
- Swacchta Pakhwada (Fortnight) was celebrated from 1 to 15 August 2018 under Swacch va Swasth Bharat Abhiyan.
- The Cleanliness Drive was conducted under Swatcha Bahrat Abhiyan on 14 August 2018 in the College campus. Total 80 volunteers took part in this drive. Dr. Ashok Agrawal, Principal, Dr. Muckta Karmarkar, Vice-Principal were present on the occasion. Dr. Ashok Agrawal created awareness about the Swacha Bharat Abhiyan and advised that volunteers should inculcate the cleanliness habit.
- Student Development Officer Dr. Anand Buddhikot attended **Annual Planning Meet** held at SP College Pune on 30 August 2018
- .As per the directives from SPPU the collection drive for **Kerala Relief Fund** was conducted in the **first week of September**. Total fund of **Rs.36**, **230**/- was collected and donated the Chief Minister Relief Fund.
- The Student Development Officer Dr. Anand Buddhikot and NSS Assistant Programme Officer, Mr. Nilesh Nemade had attended the workshop at **Department of Environmental Science**, SPPU on 21 September 2018. The workshop was organized by SPPU and **Janeev Yuva Foundation**.

Activities such as the screening of the documentary clips on Mahatma Gandhi's Thought, Cleanliness drive, exhibition and sell of books on Mahatma Gandhi and awareness drive were carried out. Also No Vehicle Day and No Horn Day were organized in the college campus.
- On 6 October 2018 Student Development Officer Dr. Anand Buddhikot attended meeting at Collector office for enrolling eligible students for voter Id.
- 15 October 2018, the Birth Anniversary of Late Dr. A P J Abdul Kalam, is celebrated as
 Vachan Prerana Divas. On the occasion the display of Books on the life of Dr. A P J
 Abdul Kalam and his thoughts was organized in the library with the help of NSS
 volunteers.
- On **9 December** two students participated in **Dr. PC Alexender elocution** competition.
- **Total four girl students,** Aditi Despande FY BBA, Tejal Thete SY BCom, Swaroopa Gandhi SY BA, Tanvi Mazire TY B.Com prarticipated in **Swayamshidha Camp**. The camp was organized from **12 to 15 December 2018** at Sharadabai Pawar Mahila Mahavidyalay, Sharadanagar Dist.Baramati.

Activities Conducted under Students' Development

The College received sanction for various proposals under the Students' Development namely Disaster management, Creative Writing Workshop, Consumer Protection in Online Transations, Cyber Security, Advance Microcontroller Training Workshop, IPR need and Importance and Android App Development from the Board of Students' Development, SPPU, Pune.

Days Disaster Management Workshop proposal got a sanctioned of Rs.25, 000/-. Two Days Disaster Management Workshop was conducted on 14 and 15 January 2019. The function was presided over by Principal Dr. Ashok Agrawal. The workshop was inaugurated at the hands of Dr. Arun Bapat. Dr. Muckta Karmarkar, Vice Principal, Dr. Anand Buddhikot, Student Development Officer, Sachin Deokate, NSS Programme Officer and Mr. Nilesh Nemade, NSS Asst. Programme Officer were present for the inaugural function. Dr. Anand Buddhikot gave information about the activities that would be conducted during the workshop. Principal Dr. Ashok Agrawal welcomed all the participants and gave best wishes for the workshop.

The first session was conducted by **Dr. Arun Bapat**. The second session was conducted by **Master trainer Shri. V. S Naidu** from **District Disaster Management Cell Pune**.

The third and fourth session was conducted by Civil Defense, Pune. Assistant Deputy Controller Shri. Arjun Khurade and his team conducted the sessions which was followed by demonstration. On the second day, Fire Station Officer Shri. Gajanan Pathrudkar and his team conducted a session on fire fighting along with demonstrations at the College ground. The third and fourth session was conducted by National Disaster Response Force (NDRF). Inspector Rajendra Patil and his team interacted with the students on various Pre and Post-disastrous situations and how to handle them effectively. They gave the hands on experience of emergency medical aid to the students and staff with the help of their demo kits. Total 80 students participated in the two day workshop.

• One Day Workshop on Creative Writing: A One Day Workshop on Creative Writing was organized on 5 February 2019. The Department of English and KSDC conducted the workshop jointly in association with Board of Students' Development, SPPU, Pune. Vice Principal, Dr. Muckta Karmarkar, inaugurated the workshop and felicitated Dr. Supriya Sahasrabuddhe, the Resource Person for the Workshop. She advised the participants to get started with writing and give words to their ideas. Dr. Sahasrabuddhe discussed the aspects of Creative Writing and gave examples from Indian mythology and Greek mythology to make the participants understand about the process of Creative Writing. She said that to be good at Creative Writing one must have sound knowledge of her/his culture, traditions and ancestors. She also advised the participants to develop 'inward eyes' to broaden their mental and inward vision. She explained the elements of Creative Writing such as emotions, Beauty, Love, Faith, and Experience etc. Dr. Sahasrabuddhe also gave an idea about the career opportunities available in the field of Creative Writing. She said there are job opportunities in the areas such as Mass Media, Films, Drama, Advertising, Copy Writing, and free-lancing etc.

The workshop received a good response in the form of 50 participants who came from various colleges such as St. Mira's College for Girls, Fergusson College, S.P. College and MES Garware College, Symbiosis College etc.
