Report on Analysis of Feedback (2020-21)

Introduction- Internal Quality Assurance Cell collects feedback from stakeholders-students, teachers, employers and alumni. This is handled by the Feedback Committee. They collect and analyse the feedback received and make it available to the authority for suggestions. Authorities convey the suggestions to appropriate bodies so as to initiate the action for improvement. Due to Covid 19 the feedback collection process has been done in online mode.

Objective- The objective of taking feedback from stakeholders is to determine the impact of all efforts taken by the college to improve the quality of holistic development.

Methodology + **Process**- Feedback on curriculum is collected from the students by uploading the link of Feedback Form on WhatsApp group of students. The Questionnaire consists of 7 questions like regular updates in curriculum, personality development, career goal and real-life issues, and all-round development of the student. Feedback from teachers is also collected.

After collecting the data, it was analysed by the Feedback Committee. The Statistical data is handed over to the authority. College authority and head of the department discuss the suggestions and feasibility of implementing the suggestions. The suggestions made by the authority are communicated to the faculty by the head of the department. Further the suggestions are incorporated by respective departments.







BSC (CS)





- It is observed that most of the BA students agree that the curriculum is updated regularly, meets their expectations, helps in developing career goals and relevant to real life issues.


