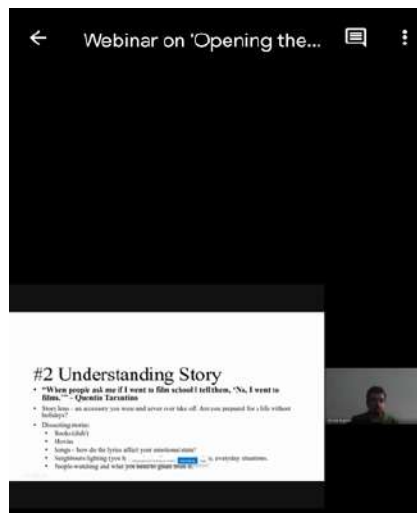
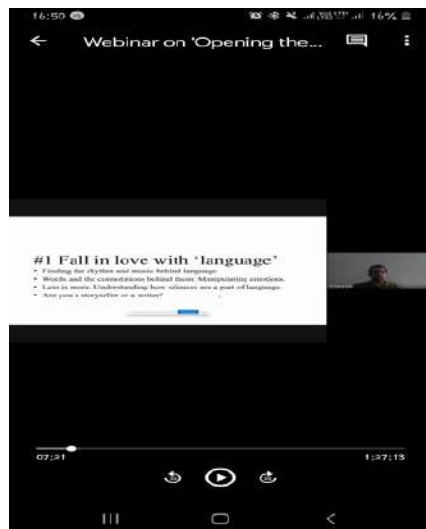
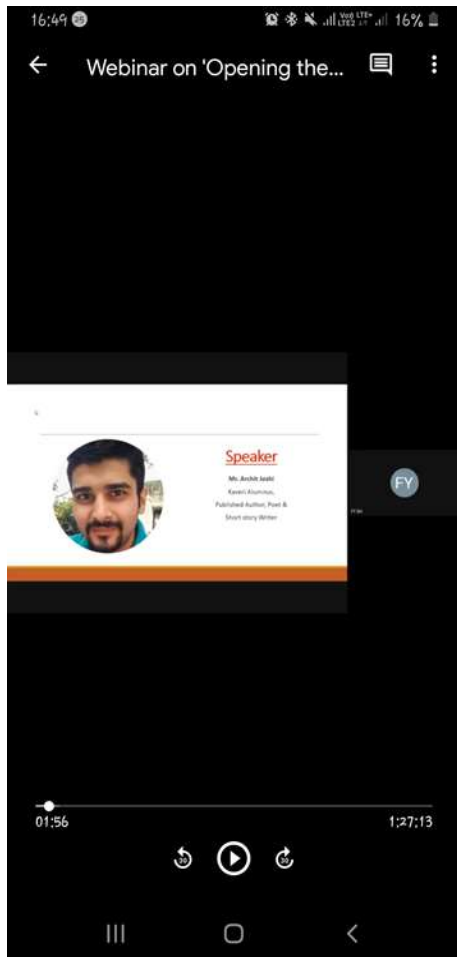

**Brief Report**

Kannada Sangha, Pune's Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce- Faculty of Arts, Department of English organized a webinar on 'Opening the Writer's Toolbox'- Key Elements of the Writing Process on Monday, 19th October, 2020. Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, the webinar was scheduled on the online platform of Google Meet.

Mr. Archit Joshi was the guest speaker for the day. Mr. Joshi, an alumnus of Kaveri College holds a Master's degree in Computer Science from Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce. He is currently working as a technical content writer at LearnEd Studio. Besides, he is a published author, poet and a short story writer. Mr. Joshi guided the participants on the techniques involved in the process of writing and publishing. While explaining the techniques, Mr. Joshi asked the participants to "fall in love with 'language'", and explained the importance of language. He encouraged them to find the rhythm and music in language. He also mentioned the importance behind understanding a story and dissecting it into parts. Mr. Joshi emphasised on writing evocatively and being authentic while writing. He asked the participants to interact with people around in day-to-day life, and surround themselves with their heroes in order to develop the characters in the story. Also, he asked the participants to be themselves and tell stories that only they can tell. Mr. Archit Joshi also gave numerous tips to the participants on how to shape their stories, and on carrying out research during the process of story writing. He also spoke about the editing skills required in order to write a successful story. In the end, he shared his ideas on how one must go for publishing his/her stories and gave the golden words, "never pay to publish" to the participants. The session also included a 'Question and Answer' segment, where the participants interacted with Mr. Joshi and got their queries answered. Ms. Gayatri Joshi, a student of First Year Bachelor of Arts, proposed the vote of thanks. Around 80 participants from various fields including students, budding writers and teachers were benefited from

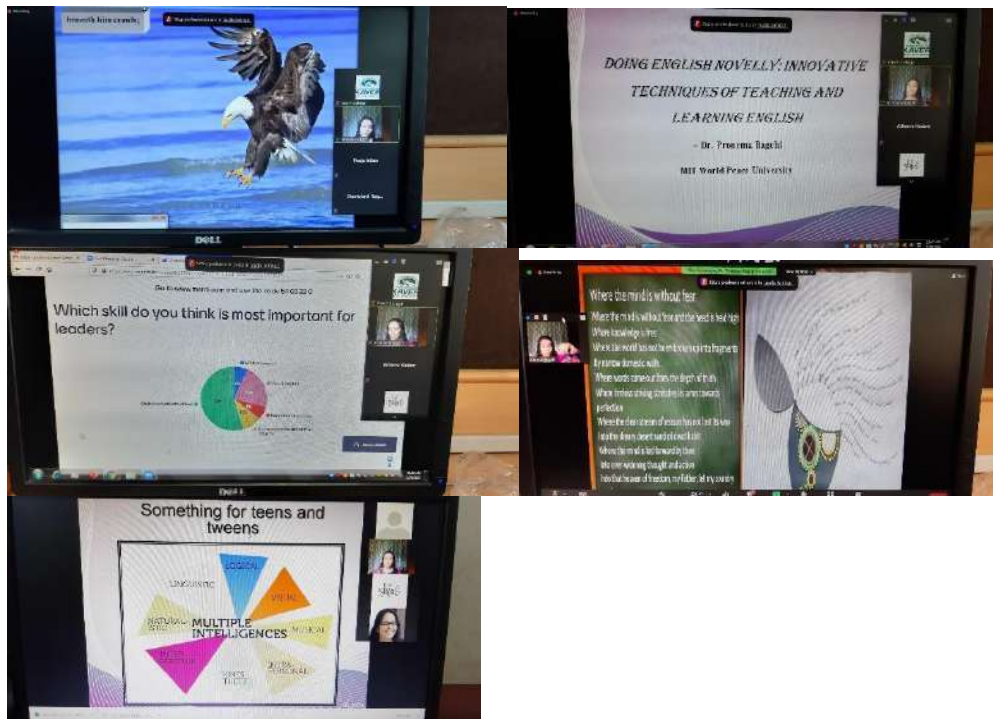

### Brief Report

The Department of English of Kannada Sangha, Pune’s Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce- Faculty of Arts, organized a webinar on ‘Doing English Novelty- Innovative Techniques of Teaching and Learning English’ on 20 February, 2021.

Dr. Pronema Bagchi, the guest speaker, began the technical session with an ice-breaker activity by taking a survey on a question. The poll was conducted by Dr. Bagchi and later the results were declared. Dr. Bagchi suggested the participants, which included teachers from various institutes, opt for a toll called ‘mentimeter.com’ for creating interactive powerpoint presentations during the new normal. She said that the most important part concerned with teaching and learning is the willingness to communicate. She mentioned the ACTFL model (American Council on the Teaching of Foreign Languages) and gave the four ‘C’s- Communities, Culture, Connections, and Comparisons. She mentioned the ubiquitous nature of English as well. Dr. Bagchi also brought forth the necessity of communication in learning any language. She suggested the teachers use the three modes for teaching- Presentational, Interpersonal and Interpretative. For learners present as participants for the session, she said that if they follow the same model along with the four learning skills, Listening, Speaking, Reading and Writing (LSRW), nothing would stop them from becoming the best communicators. She explained that ,’Doing Language through Literature’ is one of the methods of doing English novelty. Dr. Bagchi gave a few tips on designing the teacher’s English lessons by following the pre-teaching, teaching and post-teaching activities including A-V aids, interaction and games. She took up two poems as examples for teaching innovatively. The teaching of poems involved activities like Listening with Eyes’, composing a new poem from the last line of a poem, etc. The session was filled with interaction with the participants in the session by Dr. Bagchi. At the end of the session talked about the theory of ‘Multiple Intelligences’ by Howard Gardiner. Around 50 participants benefited from the session.

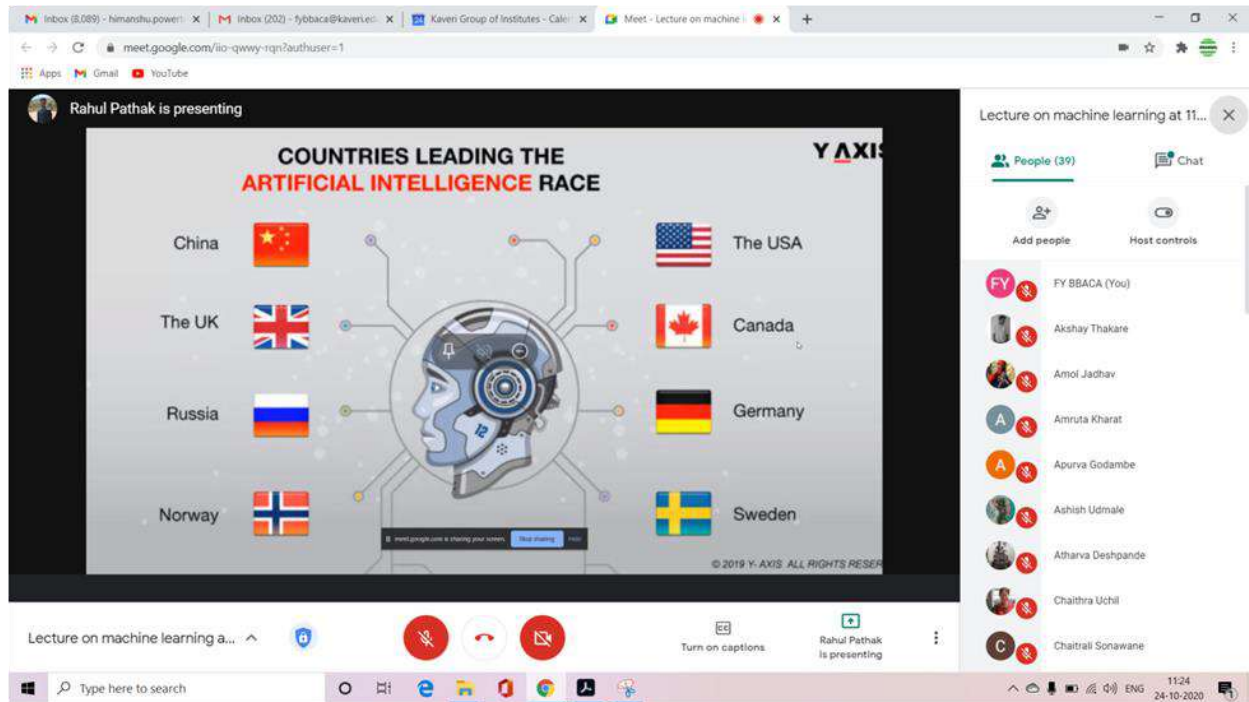
### Brief Report

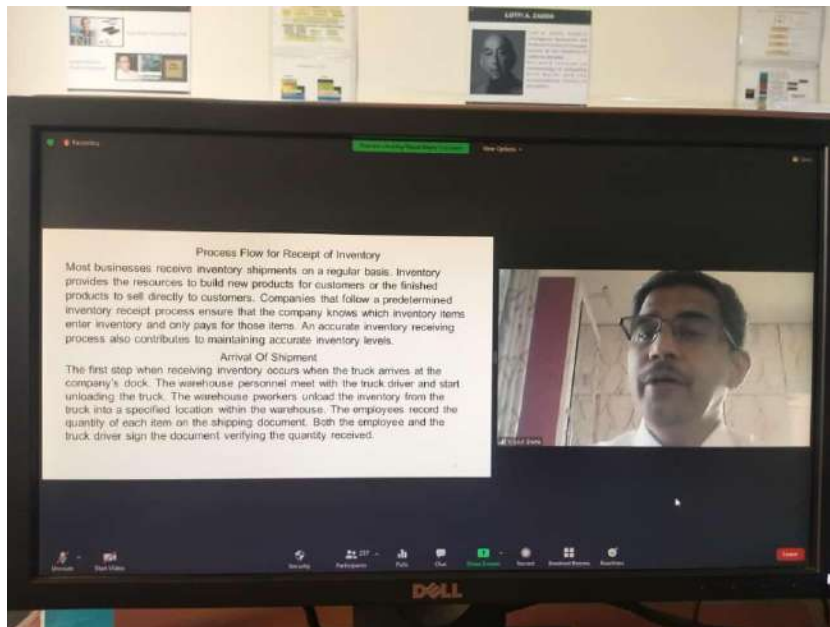


Figure 3 CMA Vinod Shete addressing the participants during the session.

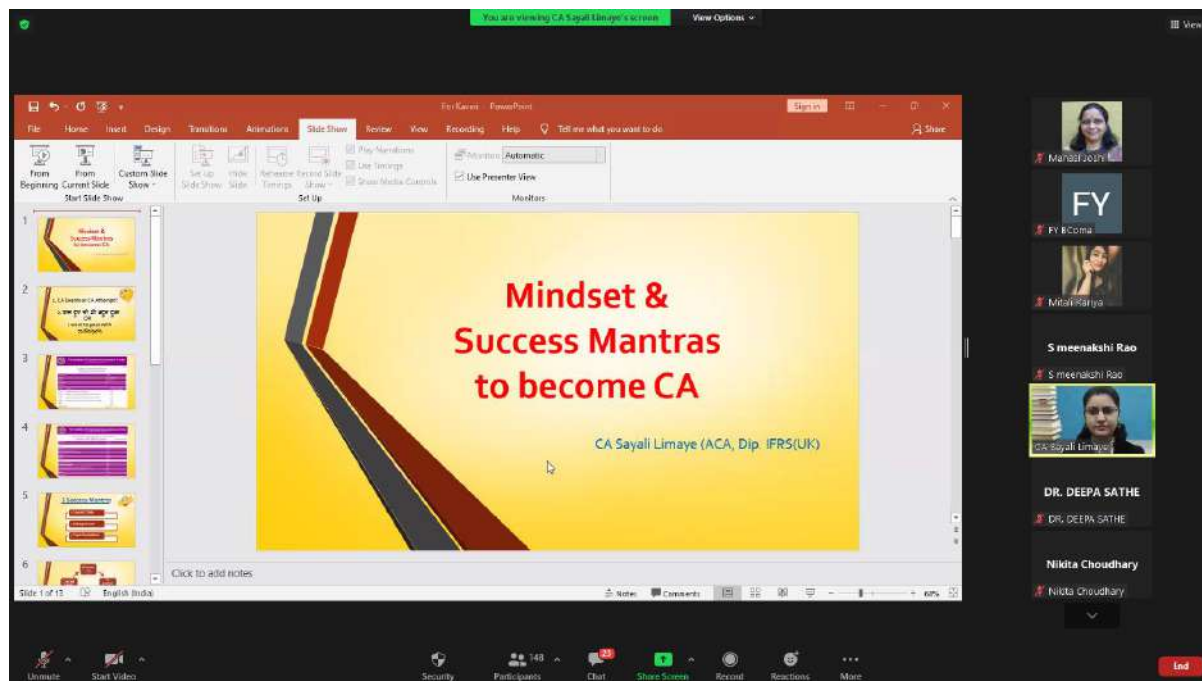

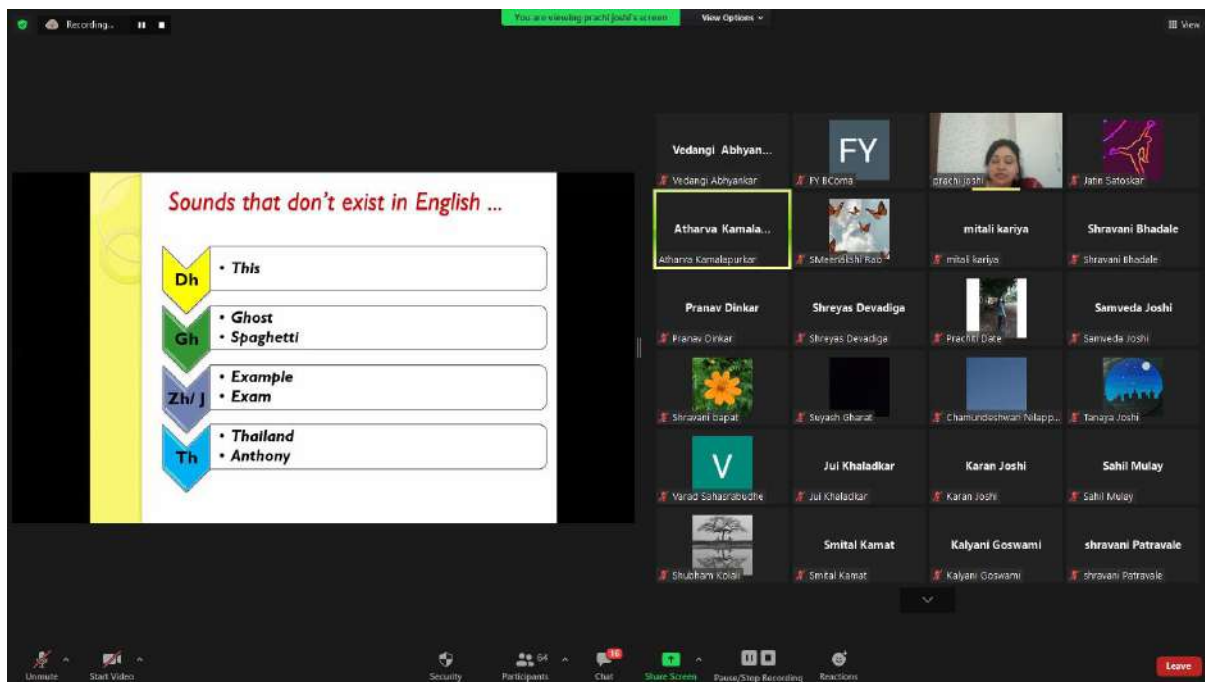

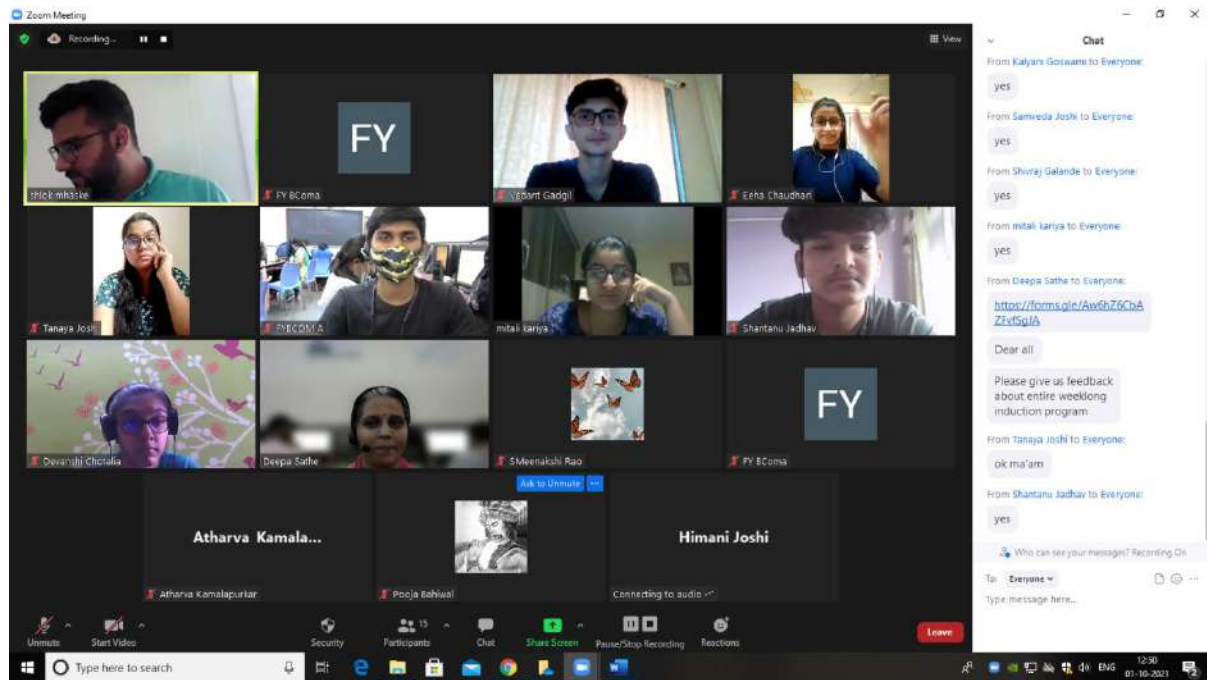

**Figure 7 Guest speaker Ms. Prachi Joshi, explaining the concepts of communication.**

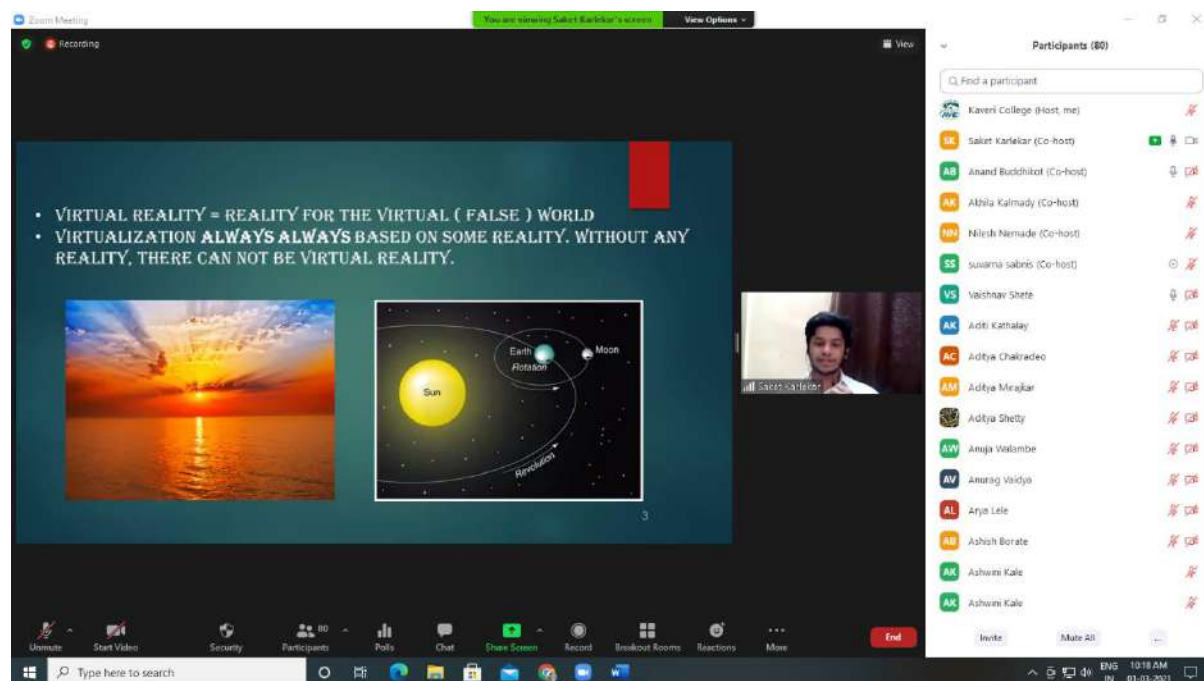

The Department of Psychology of Kannada Sangha, Pune's Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce, in association with Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation organized a webinar on '**Exploring Specific Learning Disorders and Role of Psychologist'** on Tuesday, 9<sup>th</sup> February 2021 from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm. Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, the webinar was scheduled on the online platform of Google Meet.

Ms Medha Pathak was the guest speaker for the day. Ms. Pathak, a RCI registered Special Educator. She has completed her Masters in Clinical Psychology and also has a PG Diploma in Child and Family Counselling. She has a total of 14 years of experience in the field of Assessment of Specific Learning Disorders and ADHD. She has been in charge of managing the training and collaborations at Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation, which is the only institute in India to be accredited by International Dyslexia Association and has been dedicated to work with children suffering from complex conditions of learning disabilities. She began the session with giving a basic structure of what she would be unfolding in the session. She gave an overview of what Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation is about and the range of activities which are conducted at their centre with a total strength of around 35 experts which compose of counsellors and educators. The vision and goals of making students' performance more effective and reaching a larger population while engaging in more associations were also mentioned. She also threw some light on what categories of Remediation and Assessment are done and how Teacher's Training and influential tools are crucial in bringing about a change in the children. She emphasised the importance of avoiding unnecessary labelling and how different factors like lack of access, cultural differences, mental disorders and visual impairments can be misunderstood as having learning disabilities. So, focusing on the required components and also understanding that someone's economic conditions or ethnicity do not cause the disorders were also mentioned for developing the basic concept of clearing up what these disabilities exactly mean and how one should classify them on the basis of the symptoms accordingly. Last but not the least, she concluded the session with providing some details with the possible career avenues in this field with the mandatory certifications essential for ethical practice. Around 55 participants from various fields including students, teachers, counsellors and other working professionals benefited from this session.

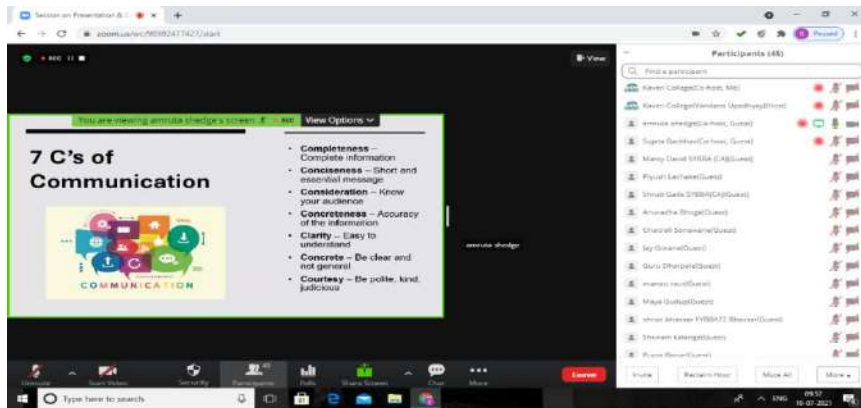

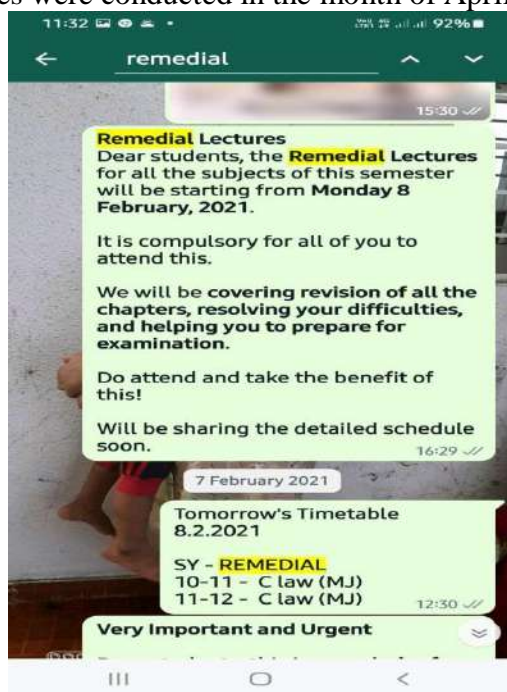

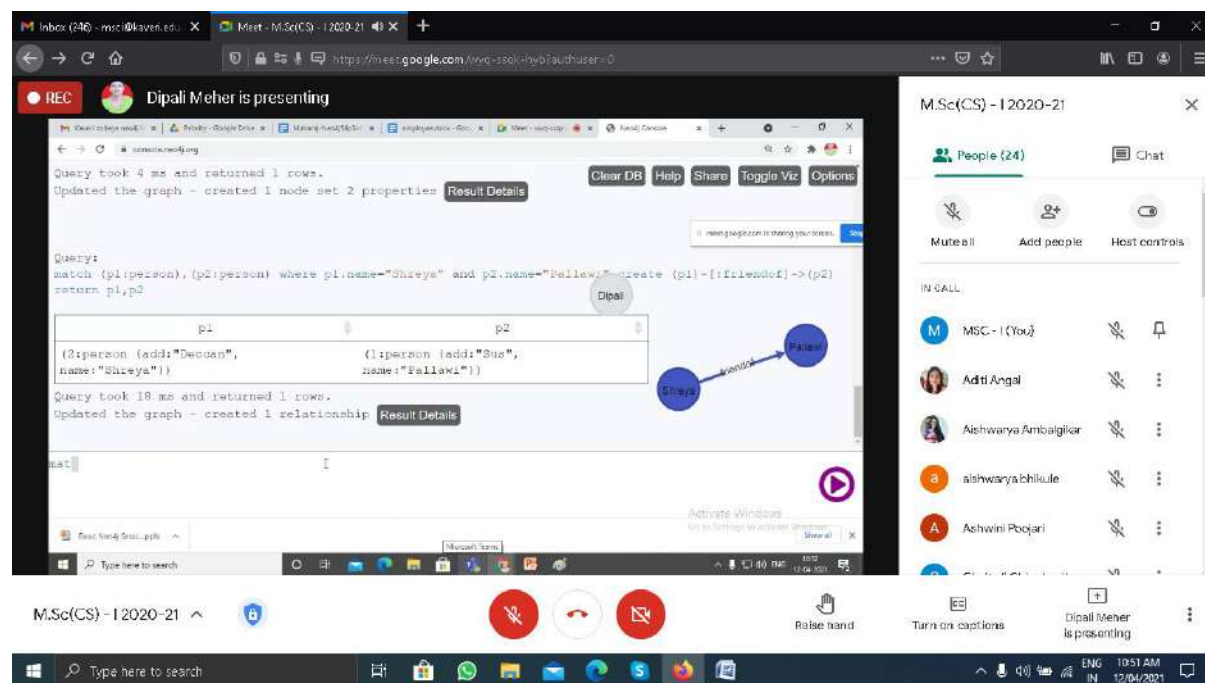
