Evaluation for Internal exam: 60 Marks (2 Hours) written test will be conducted in the second week of January, further converted into 20 marks. The students who fail the internal examination are called for remedial lectures in second term and RETEST of such students are taken. Marks are evaluated on the basis of their performance on the Internal exam or Remedial Retest exam, whichever is higher.

BBA(CA) Internal Examination & Evaluation Pattern 2020-21

For 2013 pattern TY:

The internal assessment is of 20 marks for each theory subject.

A. Written Examination worth 10 marks:-

30 marks are allotted for one written internal paper per theory subject to be taken to be converted to 10marks.

B. Three Assignments per subject for 10 marks:-

30 marks are allotted for the assignments which are converted to 10 marks.

This is how the total 20 marks for internal assessment are allotted.

For CBCS Pattern FY & SY:


The internal assessment is of 30 marks for each subject.

A. Two Class tests worth 20 marks:-

Two class tests per subject to be taken to be converted in 20 marks.

B. Two different evaluation activities per subject for 5 marks each (2activities x 5 Marks = 10 marks)

Students will be evaluated on the basis of best of two out of following seminars, presentations, assignments, group discussion, small projects etc.

I) Examination Pattern (According to 2013 Pattern (Currently applicable to SY & TY))

1. University Evaluation – 80 marks
2. Internal Evaluation – 20 marks
3. Internal Evaluation Pattern :
 - a. One internal test - evaluated out of 60 converted into out of 10.
 - b. Assignments for each subject (which includes – programs, written assignments, problem solving assignments, seminar etc) – each evaluated out of 10 and best three converted into out of 10.
 - c. For practical and Project
External exam- practical exam conducted by SPPU evaluated out of 100.
4. ATKT Rules – A student shall be allowed to keep term for the Second Year, if he/she has a backlog of not more than three theory & one practical or four theory heads of total number of subjects of the First year examination, which consist of First & Second Semester.
A student shall be allowed to keep term for the Third year, if he/she has no backlog of first Year & if he/she has a backlog of not more than three theory & one practical or four theory heads of total number of subject of the Second Year examination which consist of Third & Fourth Semester.
5. Passing Rules – Total 40% marks for passing (Min 32 marks must be obtained in University Examination)





 - a. for theory:
 - i. Minimum 2 internal tests - evaluated out of 20 convert it into out of 10
 - ii. Remaining ¹⁰20 marks for assignments, tutorials, seminars, presentations, group discussion etc. Each evaluated out of 5
 - b. For practicals
External exam - practical exam conducted by SPPU evaluated out of 100.

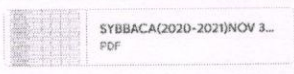

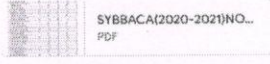
