



Deshmukh shared corporate manners to be followed during meetings, on telephone etc. He gave various tips to observe the good manners and etiquette in the corporate world.

Mrs. Pallavi Joshi proposed Vote of Thanks to all the stakeholders involved to make this event successful.



Mr. Amey Agrawal, Founder, Skillslate foundation, successfully made the entire four-day event YouTube live reaching the maximum number of participants.


Brief Report

Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, the webinar was scheduled on the online platform of Google Meet.

Mr. Archit Joshi was the guest speaker for the day. Mr. Joshi, an alumnus of Kaveri College holds a Master's degree in Computer Science from Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce. He is currently working as a technical content writer at LearnEd Studio. Besides, he is a published author, poet and a short story writer. Mr. Joshi guided the participants on the techniques involved in the process of writing and publishing. While explaining the techniques, Mr. Joshi asked the participants to "fall in love with 'language'", and explained the importance of language. He encouraged them to find the rhythm and music in language. He also mentioned the importance behind understanding a story and dissecting it into parts. Mr. Joshi emphasized on writing evocatively and being authentic while writing. He asked the participants to interact with people around in day-to-day life, and surround themselves with their heroes in order to develop the characters in the story. Also, he asked the participants to be themselves and tell stories that only they can tell. Mr. Archit Joshi also gave numerous tips to the participants on how to shape their stories, and on carrying out research during the process of story writing. He also spoke about the editing skills required in order to write a successful story. 
The session was very interactive, informative and interesting.

The Department of Psychology of Kannada Sangha, Pune's Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce, in association with Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation organized a webinar on 'Exploring Specific Learning Disorders and Role of Psychologist' on Tuesday, 9th February 2021 from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm. Owing to the COVID-19 pandemic, the webinar was scheduled on the online platform of Google Meet.

Ms Medha Pathak was the guest speaker for the day. Ms. Pathak, a RCI registered Special Educator. She has completed her Masters in Clinical Psychology and also has a PG Diploma in Child and Family Counseling. She has a total of 14 years of experience in the field of Assessment of Specific Learning Disorders and ADHD. She has been in charge of managing the training and collaborations at Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation, which is the only institute in India to be accredited by International Dyslexia Association and has been dedicated to work with children suffering from complex conditions of learning disabilities. She began the session with giving a basic structure of what she would be unfolding in the session. She gave an overview of what Anjali Morris Education and Health Foundation is about and the range of activities which are conducted at their centre with a total strength of around 35 experts which compose of counselors and educators. The vision and goals of making students' performance more effective and reaching a larger population with engaging in more associations were also mentioned. She also threw some light on what categories of Remediation and Assessment are done and how Teacher's Training and influential tools are crucial in bringing about a change in the children. She emphasized the importance of avoiding unnecessary labeling and how different factors like lack of access, cultural differences, mental disorders and visual impairments can be misunderstood as having learning disabilities. So, focusing on the required components and also understanding that someone's economic conditions or ethnicity do not cause the disorders were also mentioned for developing the basic concept clearing of what these disabilities exactly mean and how should one classify them on the basis of the symptoms accordingly. Last but not the least, she concluded the session with providing some details with the possible career avenues in this field with the mandatory certifications essential for ethical practice.



Rules and guidelines while doing analytics. The workshop was interactive and ended with a question answer session.


