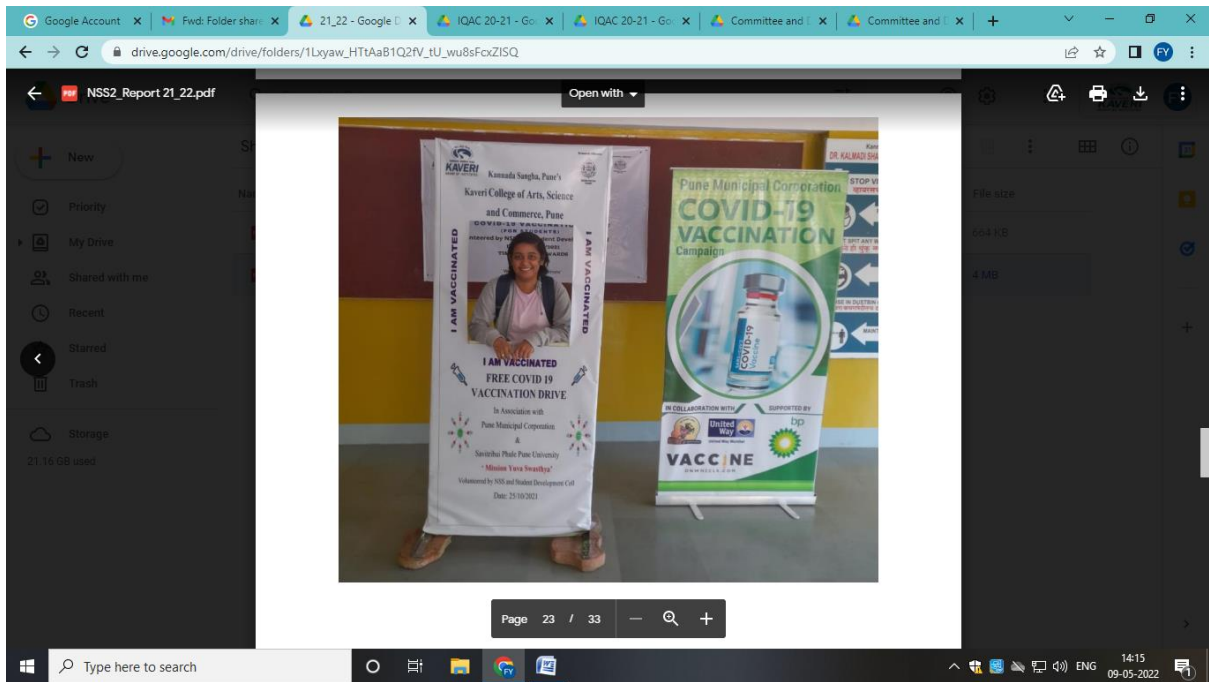
### Brief Report

**Brief Report**

On 18th January 2021, a virtual session on 'The Changing Mindset of Youth due to COVID 19' was organised by the NSS Unit.
