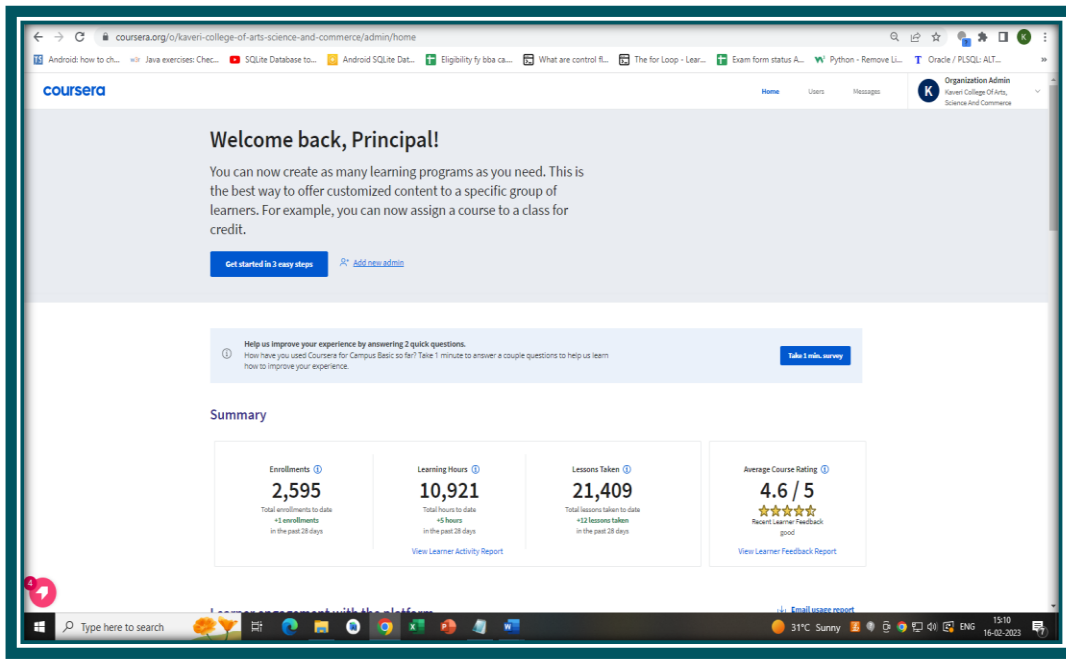

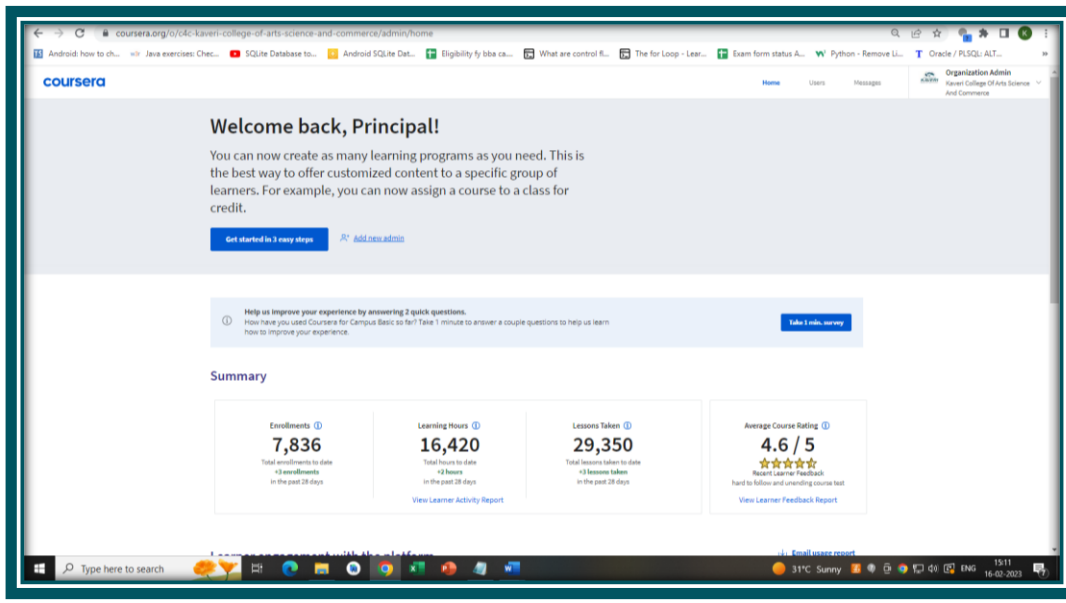
College undertook Coursera for Campus initiative for students of the college during the pandemic to provide value addition to students.



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Coursera for Campus enrollment and learning hours 2020-21



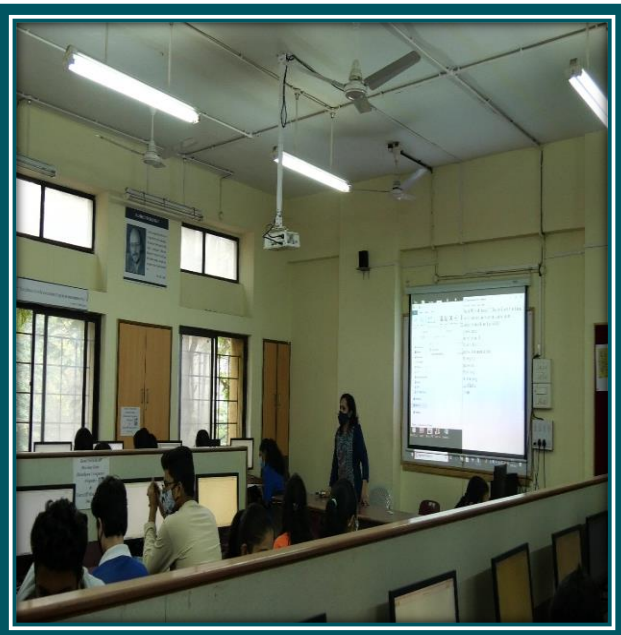
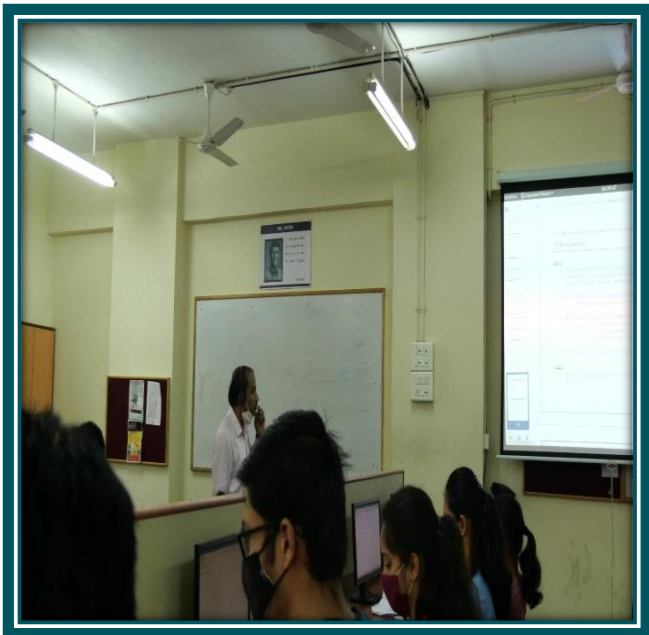

D) Promoting a Research culture

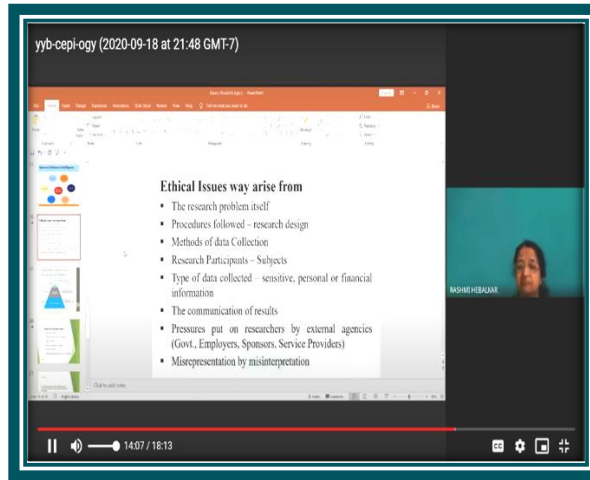
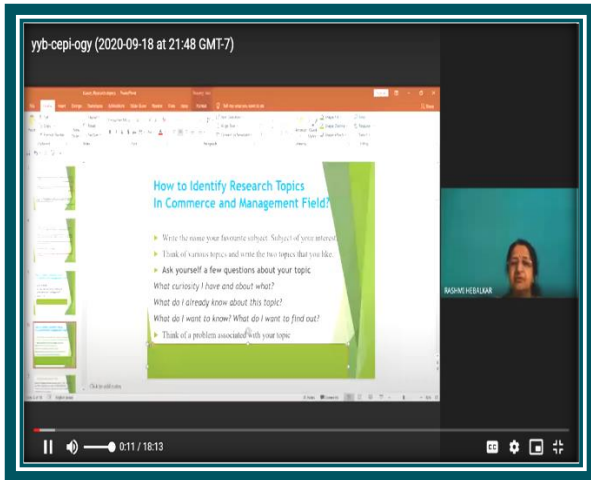
Students are encouraged to conduct research, write research papers, undertake research projects and participate in research competitions. College conducts Research related orientation programmes and encourages students to be more research oriented.



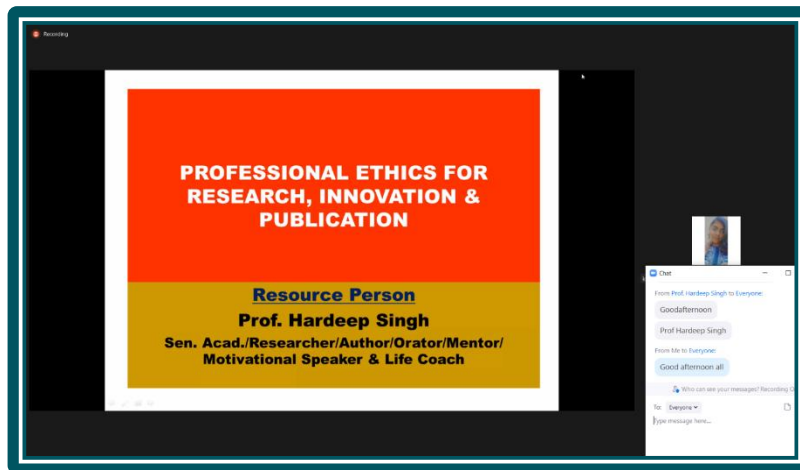

Green India Mission

MISSION OBJECTIVES-

1. To improve ecosystem services including biodiversity, hydrological services and carbon sequestration as a result of treatment of 10 m ha.
2. To increase forest-based livelihood income for 3 million forest dependent households.

National Afforestation & Eco-Development Board

The National Afforestation and Eco-Development Board (NAEB), set up in August 1992 is responsible for promoting Afforestation, tree planting, ecological restoration and eco-development activities in the country with special attention to the degraded forest areas and lands adjoining the forest areas.

GREEN HILLS GROUP

The NGO works at maximising green hills in PUNE, expanding greenery in other villages, having more focus on native plants like kaju, cocum, chikoo, etc. Also it aims at collecting seeds of these native plants from hills and providing to nurseries and building tree data using GPS and showing the same in GOOGLE MAP.

CONCLUSIONS:

1. More programs drives related to Afforestation at regional level can be undertaken including participation and contribution of stakeholders.
2. With the field work at GREEN HILLS GROUP we conclude that if every college in PUNE get registered with such an NGO, the capacity of planting trees will automatically be strengthened.

 The study suggests that, if the students of every college voluntarily join hands with the NGO for these activities and ensure to dedicate all efforts and time towards environment maximum trees will be planted. Every hill will be green.

RECOMMENDATION: OUR IDEA AND VISION

 If in the first year of curriculum, a student sow seeds for plants then throughout the year the student will work for its maintenance and take up the responsibility of the plant. This will enhance the active participation of students and inculcate the sense of responsibility in minds of the youth towards environment protection. The campaign will then continue in the subsequent academic years. This will lead to constant contribution by the youth to the environment.

 Thus 1 student, 1 plant scheme can be introduced in every college achieving approximately 3 million plants planted by the 70+ educational institutes of SPPU in each year.

1. Collect sanitary napkins in a batch of 100.
2. Set the temperature of the machine at 480 degrees.
3. Put one batch at a time in the machine and switch on the machine.
4. Let the napkins turn into ashes completely.
5. Test the purity of the ashes and use accordingly as manure.

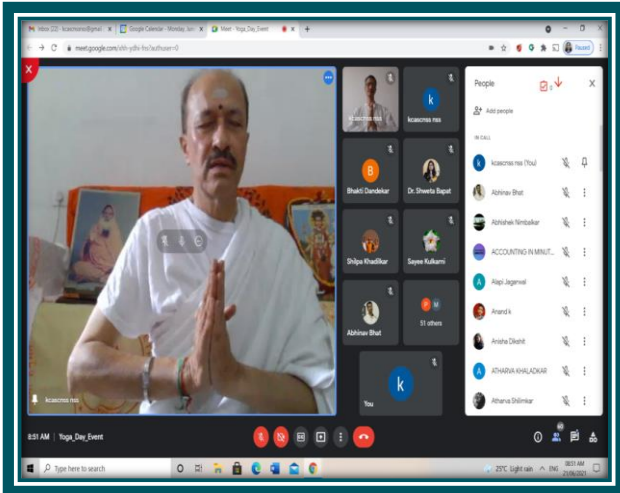
