#### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU)

Party 1 represented by Mr. Ameya Agrawal in the capacity of Founder Director Party 2 is represented by Dr. Ashok Agrawal in the capacity of Principal

#### Objective of the Agreement:

The prime objective of this agreement is to join hands and cooperate each other for the overall development of the students, faculty, youth and other stakeholders.

The two parties mutually agree upon and place on record their signature on this document with their full conscious understanding and acceptance in the matters mentioned as below:

Both the Parties shall support and collaboration to each other in matters pertaining and related to:

- 1. Provide support by specifying the requirements identified and communicate the same to the other party as mutually agreed upon from time to time, in accordance with the objective of this agreement.
- 2. Offer to deliver customized and other programs free or at cost (if any) mutually agreed upon time to time between both the parties.
- 3. Participate and support in the Academic, Curricular, Co-Curricular and extension activities as mutually agreed upon from time to time.
- 4. Collaborate in the overall development of the students by providing inputs through Special Lecture, Training Programs and Workshops etc. to enhance the employability skills and holistic development of the students, youth, faculty and other stakeholders as mutually agreed upon time to time.

5. Collaborate on initiatives for the betterment of the students, youth, faculty and other stakeholders as mutually agreed upon time to time.

Further (a) Both parties will mutually decide the scope of initiatives and reserve the right to not take up a specific initiative and (b) In case any initiative has any cost-implications, which can be mutually, decided time to time.

- 1. This is a non-commercial, non-financial MoU and does not make any compulsion on either party for any specific activities etc. The actual nature and scope of activities and financial (if any) shall be decided through mutual agreement time to time.
- 2. This MoU does not restrict either party to enter into a similar MoU with any other party/organization.
- 3. The prime objective of this agreement is to join hands and co-operate each other for the overall development of the students, youth, faculty and other stakeholders.
- 4. Initially, this agreement shall be for a period of **Three Years** from the date of signing and is further extendable as mutually agreed that time. However, it can be terminated by giving prior notice by either party.






Mr. Amey Agrawal, Founder, Skillslate foundation, successfully made the entire four-day event YouTube live reaching the maximum number of participants.


The workshop was conducted by Mr. Sameer Panchadhari Founder Director, Aayati Solutions.




The session was very interactive, informative and interesting.

Total 2000 students from various colleges/institutes across India and Abroad had registered for the workshop.




Mr. Sameer Panchadhari giving a demo of website development through Wordpress on 3 and 4 February 2021







Day 1 -





Day 2 -





#### **Report:**



Mr. Hardip Singh, International Traniner, Academician & Researcher was the resouce person for the workshop.




Date: 11 and 12 December 2021






#### **Report:**








Dr. Ravindra Kshirsagar addressing the participants of Kaveri Science Festival on 20 January 2022


#### Report:

Mr. Kunal Pagaria who is working as software development specialist at Amdocs India and having 11 years of professional experience was the resource person for the workshop.



Mr. Kunal Pagariya explaining about React on 28 January 2022



Name of the Activity: National Level Conference on Mental Health and Economic Perspective

Date: 12 February 2022

#### Report:

Kannada Sangha Pune's Kaveri College of Arts, Science and Commerce, Pune in association with Central University of Haryana organised a One Day National Level Conference on Mental Health & Economic Perspective on 12 February 2022, in association with SkillSlate Foundation, Pune.

With the objective of understanding how addressing vital aspects like policies and perspectives related to mental health can be a precursor for enhancing national wealth and prosperity and also with the objective of spreading awareness, this conference was arranged. The session witnessed the gracious presence of illustrious personalities from the field of academics and different organizations associated with the area related to mental health like: Mr. Vijay Kanhekar (*Hon. Member, Advisory Committee, Divyang Act, 2018, Maharashtra Founder, MGSS*), Prof. Tankeshwar Kumar (*Hon. Vice Chancellor, Central University of Haryana*), Mrs. Archana Deshpande (*Founder, Manah Prabodh*), Ms. Deepti Panhalkar (*Founder, Mind Spa*), Dr. Sunita Tanwar (*Faculty, Dept. of Management Studies Central University of Haryana*), Mr. Ameya Agrawal (*Founder, SkillSlate Foundation, Pune*), etc.

Prof. Dr. Tankeshwar Kumar graced the conference as the Chief Guest. During his address to the audience, he mentioned that in the backdrop of increasing suicide cases, depression, mental illness, it is important to spread awareness regarding the significance of positive mental health. He appreciated the efforts taken by the organizers in this regard. He expressed that, these days, anyone or everyone could need therapy based on mental health and stability. Ms. Malati Kalmadi (Hon. Secretary, Kannada Sangha, Pune) highlighted on the aspect that due to the pandemic there are increasing cases of issues related to mental health. And it is very important to be vocal about mental well being. She emphasized that there should be integration of body, mind and intellect so that there is movement towards spirituality and holistic upbringing. She graced the occasion as the Guest of Honour. Mr. Vijay Kanhekar, in his address, spoke on the changing perspectives towards mental illness and mental retardation. He also shared about the various provisions made by the Government, various Acts, and also spoke on significance and thoughtful implementations of schemes like 'Niramaya'. He shared very informative information regarding the technical reservations, provisions, and features regarding mental health. He graced the occasion as the Guest of Honour.

Mrs. Archana guided and spread awareness about various mental health related aspects like global perspective and economic budget, policy provisions related to mental health in India, need for changing mindsets, initiatives to be taken at social level, etc. She briefed the



participants about core strategies and goals of WHO regarding mental health and disorders. She also drived attention to the fact that with proper medical treatment, non-judgemental listening and understanding of the state of mind of the victim is of immense importance. She said that it is a remarkable change to notice the journey, from how inhuman treatment was earlier given to mentally unstable people, to the new era where human rights are applied to them and provisions are made for their betterment. She also expressed satisfaction towards the National Digital Health Ecosystem Budget, National Tele Mental Health Programme, etc. She proposed a desire about what steps the State & Central Government can take regarding mental health. She mentioned that some initiatives like having "Jan ki Baat" must be taken up in order to talk openly upon mental health. She said that it's also necessary to acknowledge and appreciate the changing paradigms in mental health from exclusion to inclusion, etc. People nowadays talk openly about mental health issues, and considering to take the necessary actions is a good sign indeed. Ms. Archana introduced the audience how social media can be effectively used to psycho educate people on a greater platform. She emphasised on the point that educational institutes too should work for focussing on innovation & skill building with academic excellence. She also encouraged the audience to contribute towards creating a ripple effect at the grassroot level. Towards the end of the session, was a Q&A session, in which participants spontaneously came up with the questions, to which Ms. Archana satisfactorily answered. This was followed with an address by Ms. Deepti Panhalkar, who shared tips regarding practicing positive mental health. She added that understanding one's thinking pattern by oneself is very important. She discussed how negative things are part of everyone's life, but one must learn to create positivity. She also assigned the audience one real time activity to practice to overcome negativity or depressions. She said depression does not happen overnight, it takes many long term factors which result in causing unstable mental health or depression. Again this session was followed by Q&A. Participants and Ms. Deepti really had a good interaction.

A closing remark was presented by Dr. Sunita Tanwar, who briefly summarised the session and added that the pandemic had shown both the sides-one of stress, depression, etc; as well as many opportunities to learn things, as people now have started to openly talk on the issues of mental health or imbalance. She appreciated the efforts taken by the organising team in planning and execution of such a distinguished valuable session. Dr. Muckta Karmarkar (Vice Principal Kaveri College) highlighted the importance of building *mental strength for a better mental health*.

The conference witnessed around 1000 participants across India from all walks of life, *viz.*, homemakers, students, teachers, professionals working in the area of mental health, other working and non-working professional. The conference was assisted by Advisory Partners - MGSS, District Disability Rehab Centre, Pune and by Acceptic Partners - MIT Arts,




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
