Report on Alternative Sources of Energy and Energy Conservation Measures

- The college installed LED Lamps for Street lights and LED Halogen Lights in Ground to conserve energy.
- There are enough lights and fans in classrooms and are used as per need. They are switched off when not in use. Natural lighting is used wherever possible.
- The college makes minimal use of Air Conditioners. Air conditioners installed in college are BEE energy efficient. Television and Refrigerator used also are certified energy efficient. Air conditioners are BEE 3 star, refrigerator is also BEE 3 star rated. Television is BEE 5 star Rates
- The college uses energy efficient electrical and electronic equipment and makes judicious use of energy in the campus.
- Rooftop Solar Panels are installed.
- Computer screens used in computer labs are LED screens
- Energy Audit is conducted to find out energy consumption and efforts are made to reduce energy consumption in campus.



Report on Management of various types of degradable and nondegradable wastes

- Waste Bins are provided on every floor for proper disposable wastes. These are collected thereafter at centralized location in the campus.
- Dry waste and Wet waste is segregated at centralized location
- Waste in the campus is collected and managed in association with SWACH organization and Pune Municipal Corporation. They collect the waste generated regularly for further management.
- E Waste Bins are placed in computer laboratories and E waste drives are conducted.
- Paper waste is managed in a responsible manner. Paper waste is first shredded and then sent to scrap dealer for further management.
- The college does not produce any hazardous or bio medical wastes

Report on Water Conservation

- The college has a well managed network of water tanks and water distribution system.
- There are two underground water tanks in the campus and overhead water tank installed in the campus. Theses water tanks are regularly cleaned and maintained.
- There is separate water tank for drinking water. Water purifiers and water coolers are installed in the campus at prominent locations for providing clean drinking water.
- The college has installed a rain water harvesting system which is functioning properly. The water collected through the rain water harvesting system is connected to the underground recharge well. This has reduced dependence on water tankers.
- The college also has a borewell connection along with the rain water harvesting system.
- A flow controller is installed to prevent overflow of overhead water tank which ensures conservation of water. Taps in washrooms are well maintained to conserve water.

Report on Green Campus Initiatives

- College is positive towards maintaining a green and clean campus and has a green policy in place.
- The college is adorned with trees and indoor plants of a variety of species such as Cassia, Bakul, Ananta, Umbar, Kanchan, Ashok etc. Indoor plants adorn the campus and are also placed on all floors.
- No Vehicle Day is observed time to time to maintain the carbon emissions and create awareness on air Pollution.
- There is restricted entry of vehicles in the campus are four wheelers of students are not allowed in campus.
- Pedestrian friendly pathways are provided and student are encouraged to make use of these pathways for walking in the campus. Use of bicycles by the students is encouraged.
- Use of single use plastic is discouraged and traditional steel containers (tambya bhande) are used instead of plastic bottles in college.

Report on Disabled Friendly barrier Free Environment

- The college has a policy for facilitation of Differently abled students. This leads to providing an inclusive environment for Divyangjan students. College follows guidelines of Government of Maharashtra and University regarding facilities and support for differently abled students.
- Necessary infrastructural facilities such as ramps and elevator are provided for Divyangjan and Senior citizens.
- Wheel chair facility is provided at the security office on request and necessary signage is put up near the ramp. Wheelchair attendant assistance is provided for Divyangjan students.
- Elevator facility is provided on the ground floor and the entire college campus is accessible by the elevator facilities. The classrooms, library and A.V room are designed at same elevation and are easily accessible.
- Washroom facility for Divyangjan is provided on the ground floor stilts and is very easily accessible by making use of ramp facility.
- For Divyangjan facilitation an open source software named Non Visual Desktop Access (NVDA) screen reader has been installed on computer.
- Facilitation for scribes (writers) has been provided to the students. Extra time is provided as per University guidelines.


