Time: Elimination round: 11:30 AM

Final Round 1:30 PM onwards

No. of Participants: 2 members (compulsory)

Participation Fees: Rs. 100 per participant

Prizes: Top 2 teams will be awarded with cash prizes and certificates. All participants will get participation e-certificate.

Guidelines for Quiz Competition:

1. Elimination round will be conducted if more than 4 teams have registered
2. 4 rounds will be conducted for final 4 selected teams
3. The quiz is a General Quiz and questions will be based on GK, Current affairs, Science and technology etc.

The Quiz will be played out in two rounds: First Elimination Round followed by main quiz

First Round - Elimination Round

1. All teams will have written elimination round.
2. The elimination round will consist of 30 questions.
3. All questions will be MCQ type based on GK, Current affairs, Commerce, Management, Arts, Science and technology etc.
4. In case of same score, time of submission will be considered.
5. First 4 teams will make it to the final round of quiz.
6. Organizers may consider tie breaker depending on situation.
7. Organizers' decision will be considered final.

Final Round of Quiz:

1. Teams will think hard, tickle their brains and will play hard in the main quiz.
2. The team which has top score in the elimination round, will get to choose which spot they will occupy among A, B, C, D.
3. The main quiz will have four rounds.

Round 1 - Q & A

- a. Four sets of one direct question per team will be asked in Round 1
- b. Questions will be on a variety of topics
- c. 10 points for every correct answer
- d. No Negative Marking**
- e. In case the question is passed, the team getting it right will score 5
- f. 30 seconds will be given for answering

Round 2 - Mosaic Round

- a. There will be **three** levels of clues pertaining to a question.
- b. Clues will be in all forms, i.e., they may be Audio Clues, Video clues, Visual clues, or simply written clues.
- c. There will be **one** correct answer connecting all the three levels of the clues.
- d. The clues will be getting easier with each passing level.
- e. 30 seconds will be given for answering
- f. Marking Scheme: **+30 for a Correct -15 for a Wrong**

Round 3 - Grid With a Twist

- a. A Grid with 6 topics will be shown.
- b. The team which is leading will get to choose their topic first and the successive teams will follow.
- c. Once a topic is chosen by a team, there will be 5 questions each of 10 points
- d. 30 seconds will be given for answering

Round 4 – Rapid Fire Questions

- a. Each team will be asked 5 questions one after another in 50 seconds time.
 - b. The question will not be forwarded to the next team.
 - c. Ten points for correct answer will be assigned
- Top 2 teams in sequence with the highest score and second highest will be the winner and runner-up for the competition respectively.
 - In case of tie, tie-breaker question will be asked.
