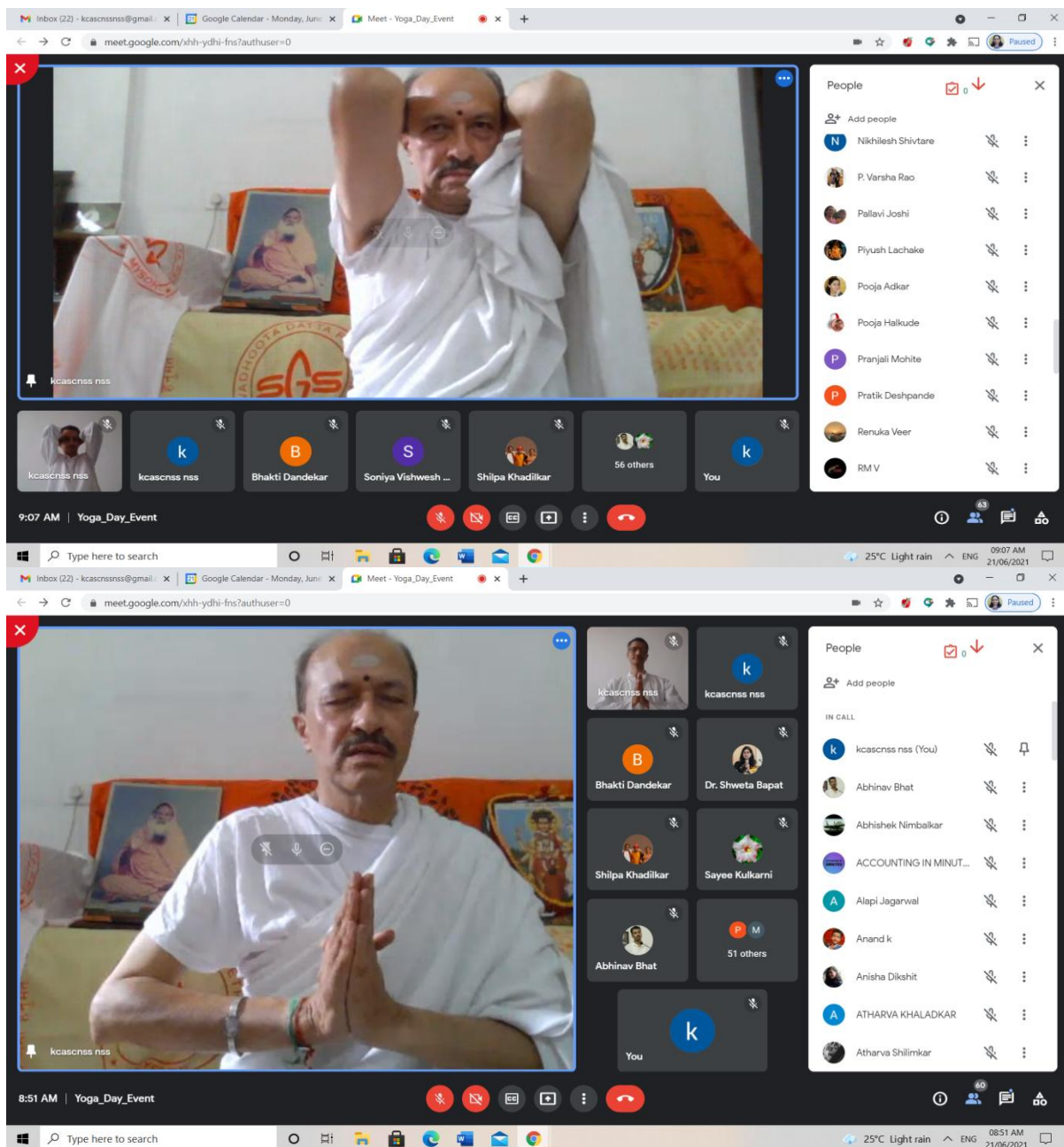

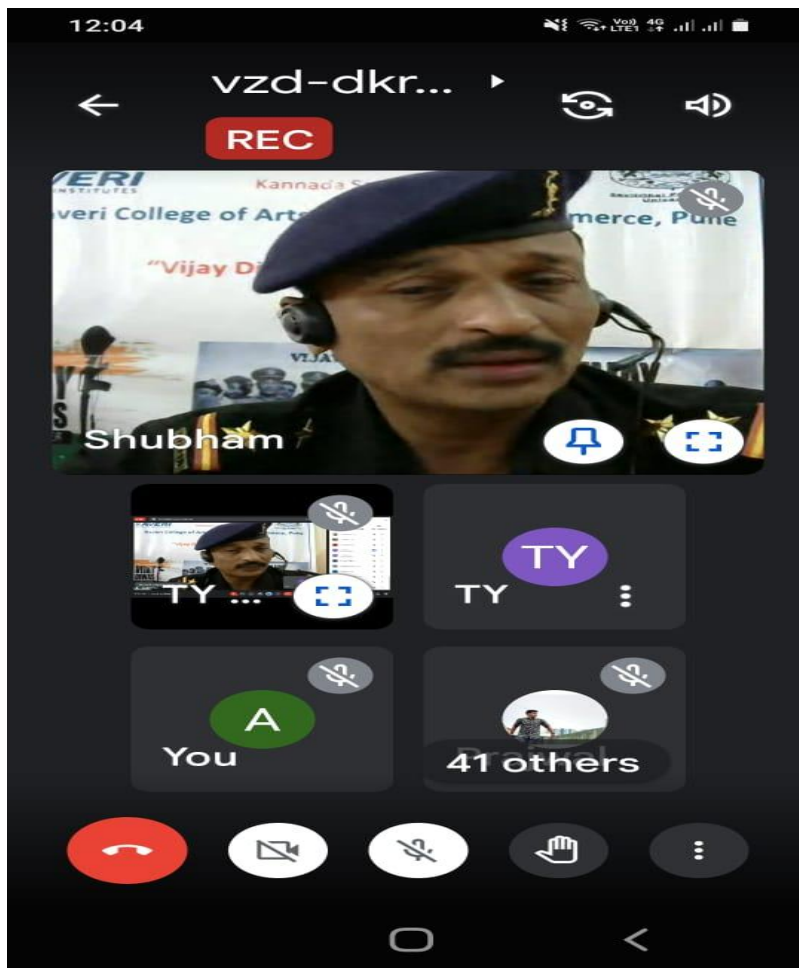
Force and Indian Navy. This year in 2021 Vijay Diwas marked the 51st anniversary celebrations of India's victory over Pakistan in 1971 war.

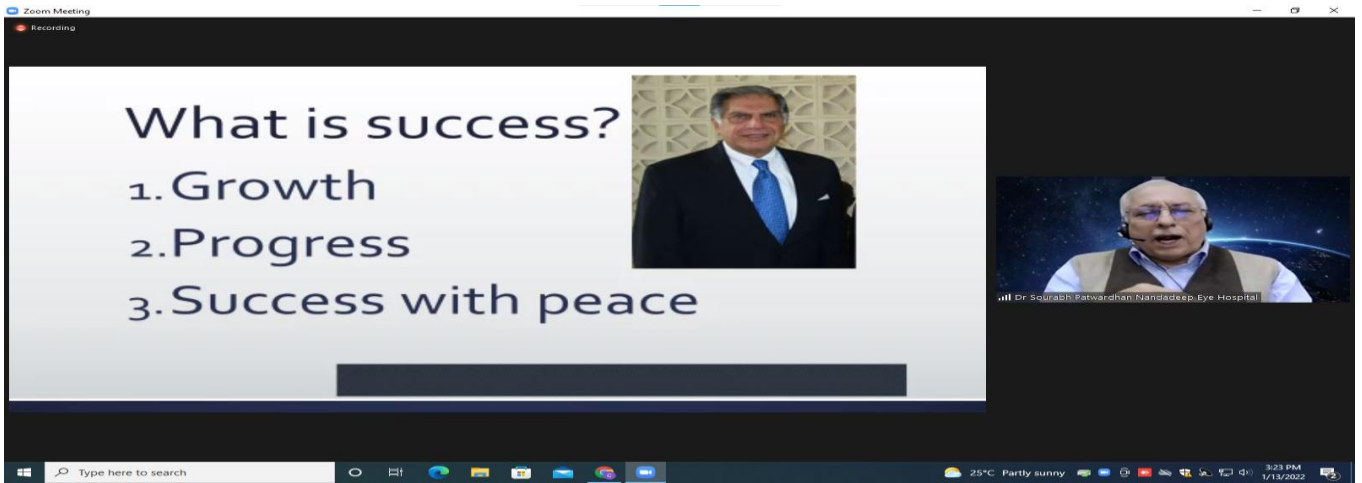
