He discussed topics such as Taxes prior to GST, Tax on Tax, Multiple Registrations, Lack of Uniformity, and Goods V. Services dilemma etc. The second technical session was conducted by renowned CA Mr. Subodh Shah. He spoke on the impact of the implementation of GST in India. He said, "With GST, India has become one big market." He also said that GST will create a unified common national market for India, giving a boost to foreign investment and the 'Make in India' campaign. CA Mr. S. S. Dhamne conducted the third session and spoke on 'Returns to be filed under GST'. He made the participants aware on how to file GST returns, format of GST returns, processing of GST returns, etc.

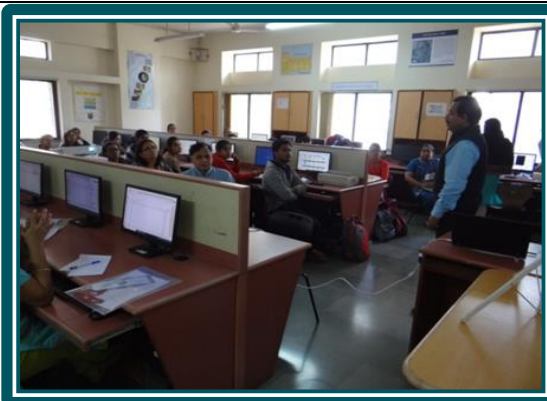

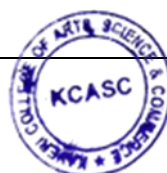
Report:

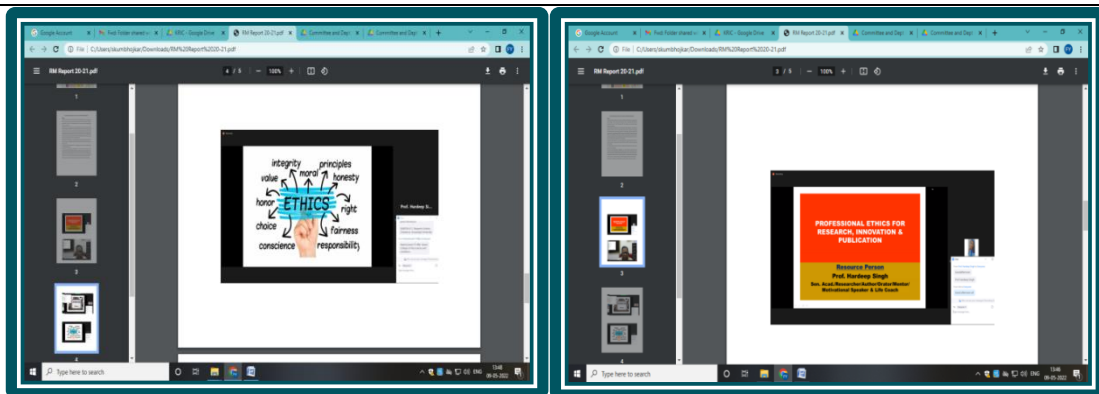

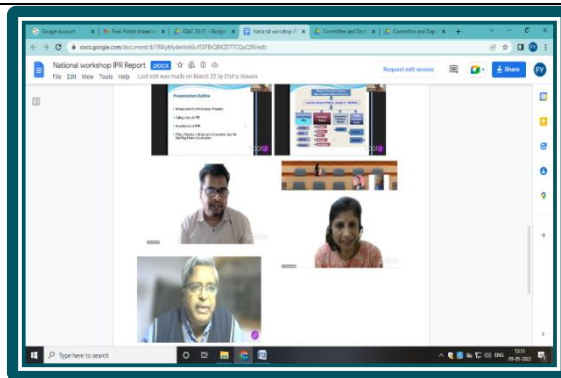
