**Introduction-** Internal Quality Assurance Cell collects feedback from stakeholders- students, teachers, employers and alumni. This is handled by the Feedback Committee. Curricular aspects focus on design, development and implementation of curricula. They collect and analyse the feedback received and make it available to the authority for suggestions. Authorities convey the suggestions to appropriate bodies so as to initiate the action for improvement.

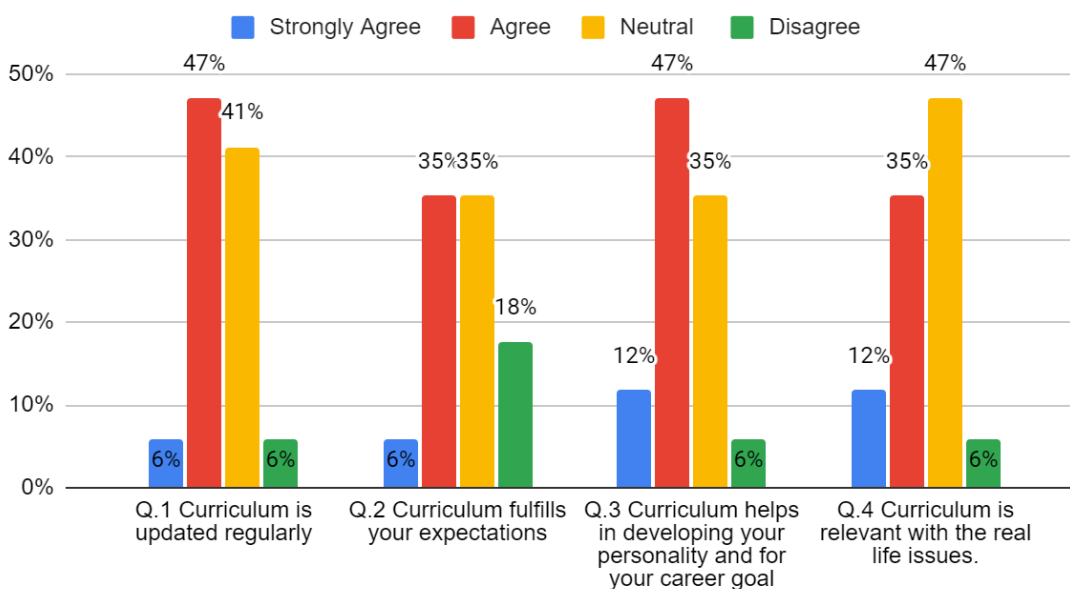
**Objective-** The objective of taking feedback from stakeholders is to determine the impact of all efforts taken by the college to improve the quality of holistic development and address relevant issues.

**Methodology + Process-** Feedback on curriculum is collected from the students by uploading the link of Feedback Form on WhatsApp group of students. The Questionnaire consists of 7 questions like regular updates in curriculum, personality development, career goal and real-life issues, and all-round development of the student. Feedback from teachers is also collected.

After collecting the data, it was analysed by the Feedback Committee. The Statistical data is handed over to the authority. College authority and head of the department discuss the suggestions and feasibility of implementing the suggestions. The suggestions made by the authority are communicated to the faculty by the head of the department. Further the suggestions are incorporated by respective departments.

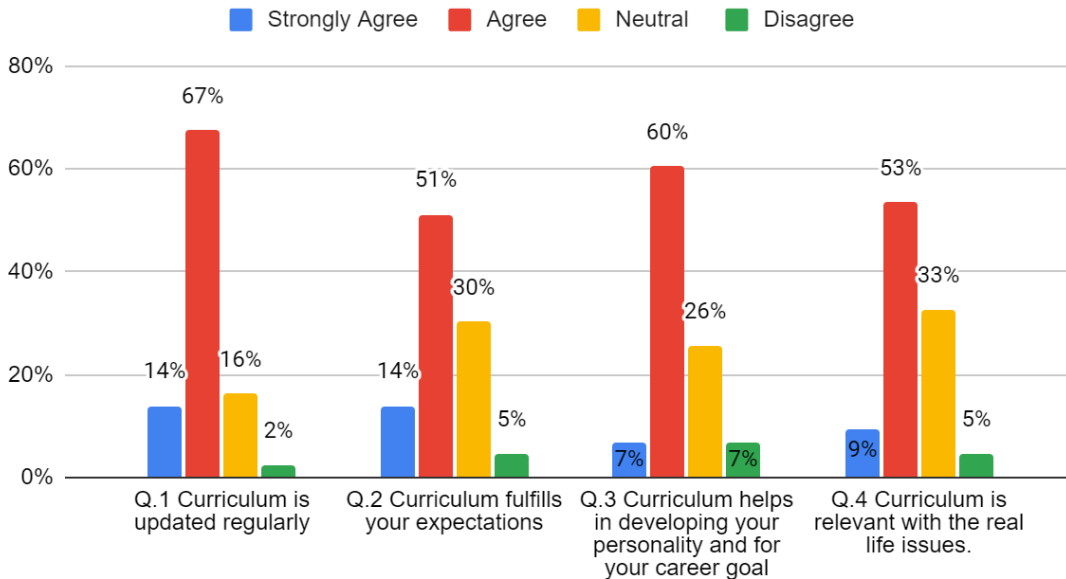
**BA Students Feedback**



- With reference to the above analysis, it is observed that 47% of the students agree that curriculum is updated regularly and it fulfills the expectations of the students.

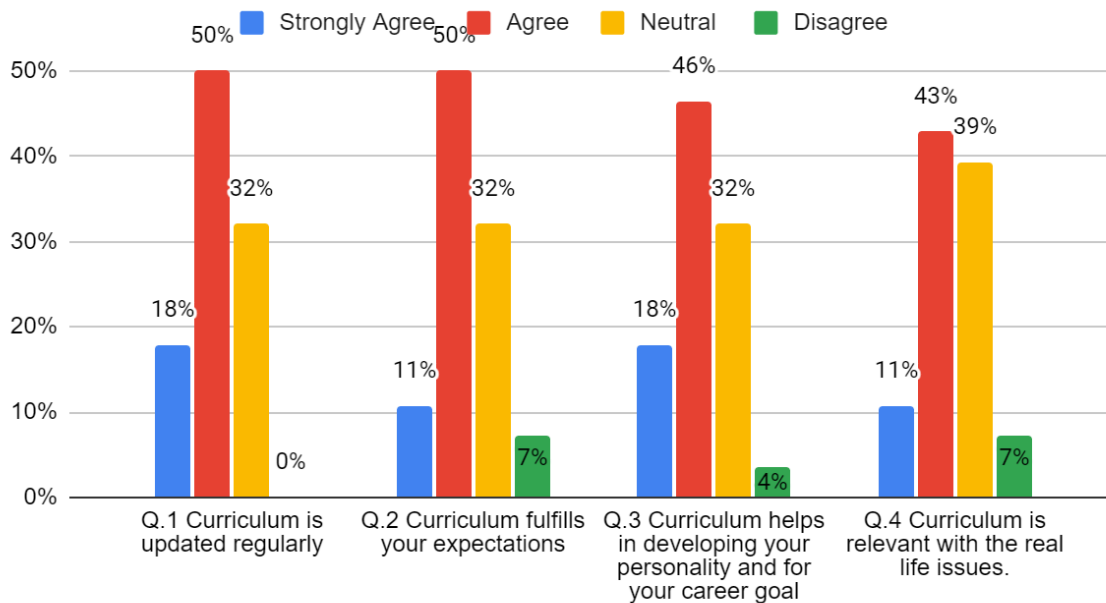
### BBA (CA) - Student Feedback

- Some of the students have suggested that the following subject / topics can be added in the syllabus

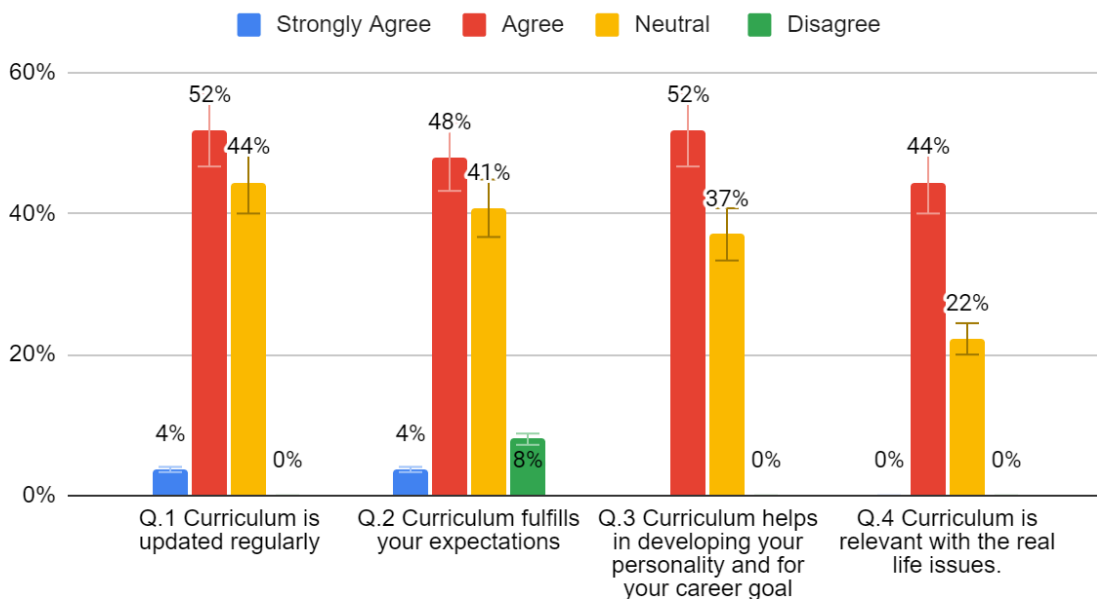

## BBA student Feedback



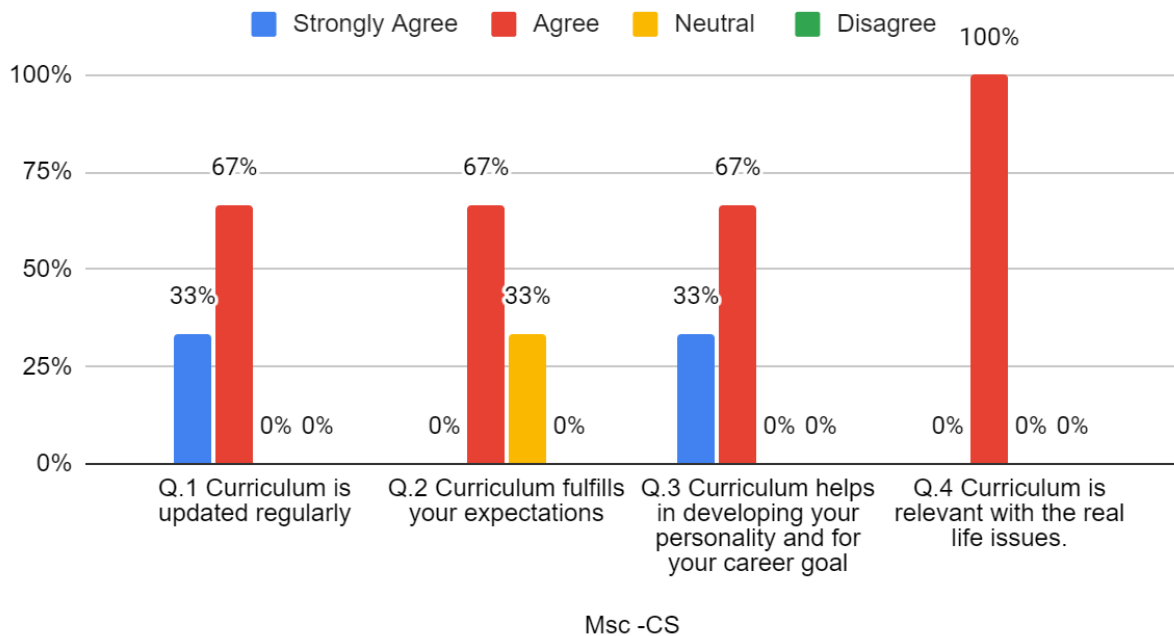

## BBA-IB Students Feedback



- With Reference to the analysis, it is observed that more than 52% of the students agree that the curriculum is updated regularly, fulfils their expectations. 52% of students say that the curriculum helps in developing career goals and relevant to real life issues.
- It is observed that maximum of the BBA(IB) students are satisfied with the curriculum, is updated regularly, meets their expectations, helps in developing career goals and relevant to real life issues.

## MSc (CS) Student Feedback



- With Reference to the analysis, it is observed that 67% of the students of Msc. agree that the curriculum is updated regularly, fulfils their expectations, helps in developing career goals and half of the students satisfied with the syllabus are relevant to real life issues. 100% of students say the curriculum is relevant to real life issues.

### Analysis and Conclusion: -

The committee analysed the responses of feedback forms received from the stakeholders and submitted it to the concerned authorities. The analysis of students and parents feedback response depicts that

- They are satisfied with curriculum and agree that the curriculum is updated regularly as well as meets their expectations
- They agree that the curriculum is relevant with real life issues
- Most of the students agree that the planned curriculum is useful in developing their personality and achieving career goals
- Students have recommended that to include some subjects in some courses in the curriculum and college is working to there
