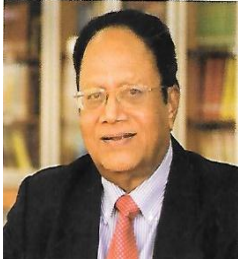

Kannada Sangha Pune, a Public Trust (registered under the Maharashtra Public Trust Act 1950) was established in 1952. It was mainly a cultural organization that promoted camaraderie amongst the Kannadigas in the city of Pune. With the visionary leadership of late Dr. Shamarao Kalmadi, late Mr. G. M. Shetty and a group of dedicated and sincere trustees and members, the Kannada Sangha Pune forayed into the realm of education with the establishment of Karnataka High School in 1963. In 1965, the Karnataka High School (both Kannada medium and English medium) was renamed Dr. Kalmadi Shamarao High School in memory of its co-founder.

As the educational needs of the city grew, the Kannada Sangha Pune expanded its infrastructure to set up its other institutions and today, apart from the Kannada Medium High School, it boasts of having Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary Schools, Junior and Senior Colleges under its umbrella. The total enrolment in these units is over 7000 students with 500 teaching faculty.

➤ NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME (MOTO – NOT ME BUT YOU)



The National Service Scheme (NSS) at Savitribai Phule Pune University has been an integral part of its academic offerings since 1969, aiming to enrich students' lives through community service. The core objective of NSS is to blend 'Education and Service' for the betterment of the community, with active participation from students. This scheme operates under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Government of India, and the NSS cell is governed by the Higher and Technical Education Department, Government of Maharashtra.

At Kaveri College, the NSS unit was initiated in 2008-09, with an allotted strength of 100 students. This platform provides students with the opportunity to engage in meaningful community service, fostering a spirit of social responsibility and leadership.

Major Activities:

- Orientation Programme: Familiarizing students with NSS values and objectives.
- International Yoga Day: Promoting health and mindfulness through yoga sessions.
- Tree Plantation Drive: Contributing to environmental conservation.
- Police Mitra Duty: Assisting local authorities during the Ganesh Festival.
- Nirmalya Collection: Encouraging eco-friendly practices during festivals.
- Theme-Based Rallies: Raising awareness on causes like Kanya Ratna Abhiyan, Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, and Cracker-Free Festivals.
- Social Awareness Events: Covering topics such as Petroleum Conservation, Water Harvesting, Waste Management, and Pollution Control.
- Swachh Bharat Abhiyan: Actively participating in the national cleanliness drive.
- Swachhta Pakhwada: Engaging in fortnightly cleanliness campaigns.
- Awareness Programs: Focusing on Road Safety, HIV/AIDS, and De-Addiction.
- No Vehicle Day: Promoting eco-friendly transportation.
- Yuva Saptah: A week-long celebration of youth empowerment.
- Blood Donation Camps: Organizing regular blood donation drives.
- Joy of Giving Week: A special initiative where volunteers, students, and staff donate items like clothing and groceries, which are distributed to charitable organizations.

NSS Special Winter Camp:

Each year, the NSS unit organizes a Special Winter Camp in a village adopted by the college. During this camp, students engage in various community projects such as:

- Conducting surveys
- Running awareness campaigns
- Organizing medical camps
- Planting trees and improving environmental conditions
- Undertaking cleanliness drives
- Developing gardens and drainage systems
- Teaching and interacting with local school children
- Prabhat Pheri: Spreading awareness on key social and environmental issues.

The NSS unit also conducts events in alignment with directives from the NSS Department of SPPU. Selected volunteers have the chance to participate in University, State, National, and International NSS camps, gaining broader exposure and valuable experiences.

➤ IMPORTANT POINTS FOR THE STUDENTS

Discipline

- Students will abide by the general rules of discipline laid down by the College authorities from time to time.
- Decency and Discipline must be maintained in the campus.
- Punctuality in all respects is of great importance in the College.
- Politeness and good manners will be expected from all students towards each other and towards all members of the staff.
- Smoking, chewing tobacco and use of drugs are strictly prohibited in the College campus.
- Students must not carry ordinary cell/smart phones during examination. They should keep phones on silent mode while attending lectures, seminars or any other programmes.
- Obedience to instructions given by the teachers and other members of the staff is essential.
- The students are advised to park their vehicles in the authorized vehicles parking space.
- Students' co-operation is solicited for keeping the College clean.
- Students will be responsible for any loss or damage of the cell phones and other valuables in the College campus
- In all the matters, the Principal's decision shall be final and binding on all students.

Grievance Redressal for Students

A Grievance Redressal Committee has been constituted by the College. Students can communicate their grievances to the committee in writing, by dropping their grievance in the drop - box placed outside the College office / in library.

Malpractices During Examinations

According to the judicial law of Maharashtra Government, resorting to any malpractices such as copying or cheating during any of College examinations is a cognizable, criminal offence



Internal Complaint Committee

(Cell for Prevention of Sexual Harassment)

The College has established Internal Complaint Committee ICC as per “The sexual harassment of women workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act 2013 and SPPU Circular No. 165/2016”. As per the Sexual harassment Act 2013 any form of sexual misconduct is treated as violation. The victim can inform or place a complaint through any member of ICC committee. Also there is suggestion box installed on the first floor where any student can place a complaint.

Prevention of Ragging and Eve Teasing on the Campus

Ragging / eve teasing is a criminal offence and there will be ‘zero tolerance’ by the College regarding cases of ragging. Students found guilty of ragging will be severely punished. If an incidence of ragging comes to the notice of the concerned authority, the accused student will be given an opportunity to explain and if his/her explanation is not satisfactory, the authority will expel him/ her from the College and he/she will have to undergo the legal proceedings.

➤ STUDENTS SUPPORT AND PROGRESSION

At Kaveri, we believe every child is unique and has potential. Given the required opportunities, the students can prosper in their chosen career path as well as in life. In order to enable students to acquire meaningful experiences for and from learning and to facilitate their holistic development and progression, the College provides numerous opportunities – curricular, co-curricular and extra-curricular.

Curricular Activities

Apart from the regular classroom teaching-learning sessions, students are offered with various forms of learning experiences like

- Guest Lectures
- Presentations by Eminent Resource Persons from Academic and Non-Academic Fields
- Hands on Training Sessions
- State and National Level Workshops, Seminars and Conferences

The main endeavour of the College Placement Cell is to provide placement assistance to students. We equip students with industry specific knowledge and soft skills which help in fostering their employability. The Vocational Guidance Cell of the College conducts several activities to make students aware about different career opportunities available and it also conducts activities to prepare students for several competitive examinations.

Industrial Visits and other field visits are arranged for students as per the University guidelines and requirement of a course. These visits are planned with the objective of letting students know about the practical relevance of the theoretical knowledge that they acquire in the process of learning their curriculum. These also enhance enthusiasm in the students and raise their inquisitiveness.

Co - Curricular Activities

To instill in students various soft skills like communication skills, self-confidence, decision-making, problem-solving, time management, team spirit, leadership skills etc., many stream-wise clubs have been established, namely,

Mentoring and Counselling

With the passage of time, the education sector is constantly going through transformation. And thus, a teacher's responsibilities have also evolved over time. Thus, there is a need for mentoring. The mentoring programme is conducted for the emotional, intellectual and societal development of the students. However, for cases of students that require professional guidance, we have provision of forwarding those cases to a counsellor.

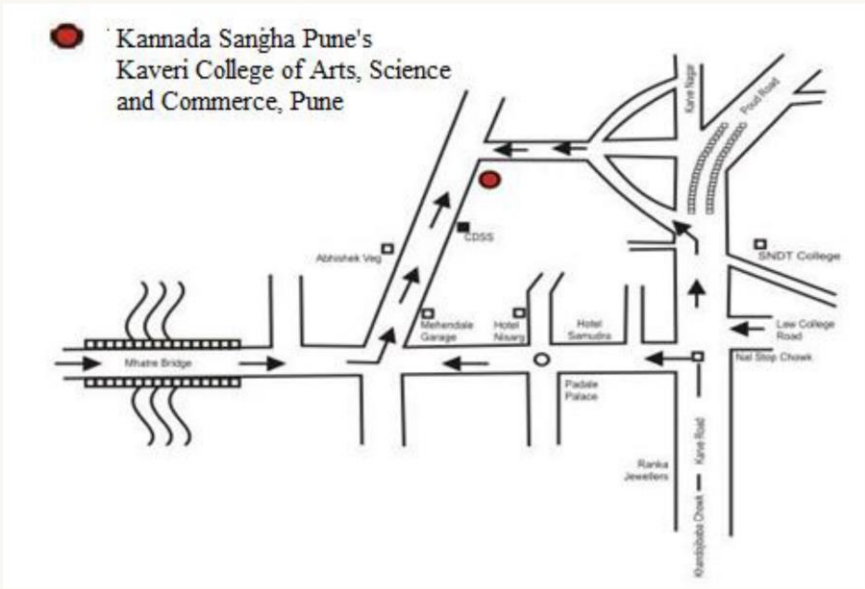
